Under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), an environmental review has been performed on the following action.

**TITLE:** Programmatic Environmental Assessment, Fisheries Financing Program

**LOCATION:** The United States, U.S. Trust Territories, and EEZ.

**SUMMARY:** The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) Headquarters, Office of Management and Budget, Fisheries Finance Program (FFP), is proposing to continue operation of the FFP to make loans to fishers, fish processors, aquaculturists and others to finance up to 80 percent of the capital cost of fisheries-related projects in 2015 and beyond. These are financial transactions, which will not change or add to the operations involved, nor change the methods by which they operate.
