







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Purpose of the Dive	Maritime heritage dive to conduct non-invasive video survey of remains of USS Baltimore, late 19 <sup>th</sup> -century USN protected cruiser scuttled near Oahu in 1944, including: documentation of specific 19 <sup>th</sup> -century features; photogrammetry and mosaic data compilation; assessment of scuttling damage; assessment of preservation/deterioration status; marine species inventory.				
Description of the Dive	Vessel was found upright and intact on the flat sandy bottom. A complete video survey was accomplished meeting all the main objectives: perimeter survey of main features; detailed photogrammetry compilation of iconic bow ram; detailed engineering spaces documentation; full deck photomosaic compilation; hull plate damage assessment. Data will enable interpretive products of this historic vessel.
