



PROVISIONAL SUMMARY OF U.S. OBSERVER ACTIVITIES AND FOREIGN AND JOINT VENTURE FISHERIES IN THE NORTHEAST PACIFIC OCEAN AND EASTERN BERING SEA, 1988

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INTRODUCTION

The Alaska Fisheries Center administers the Foreign Fisheries Observer Program, which monitions foreign and joint venture fisheries conducted within the U.S. 200-mile Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) in the northeast Pacific Ocean and Eastern Bering Sea. The Magnuson Fishery Conservation and Management Act of 1976 requires that, with some exceptions, all foreign fishing vessels and joint venture processing vessels carry a U.S. fisheries observer while conducting fishing operations within the EEZ. Foreign fishing is defined as foreign vessels that catch and process fish against a foreign quota, and joint venture fishing is defined as foreign vessels that catch and process fish against a U.S. quota. The primary purposes for the placement of observers are to collect data required for fisheries management and research and to monitor vessel compliance with U.S. fisheries regulations.

The Foreign Fisheries Observer Program prepares monthly reports summarizing observer coverage, estimates of groundfish catches, and estimates of incidental catches of species whose retention are prohibited by U.S. fishing regulations. The purpose of these reports is to keep those associated with the seasonal management of these fisheries apprised of current conditions. This document provides an annual summary of the fisheries, and includes information contained in the monthly reports for 1988. At this time, data and estimates are provisional. Estimates and final statistics for 1988 can be obtained from the Foreign Fisheries

Observer Program of the Alaska Fisheries Center, Seattle, Washington.

OBSERVER COVERAGE

(Tables 1-4)

Observer coverage (the percentage of the total foreign vessel days on ground that were sampled by observers) for 1988 was 93.9% in the foreign and joint venture fisheries in the northeast Pacific Ocean and Bering Sea, a decrease of 2.1% from coverage in 1987. Observers sampled 14,892 cumulative days aboard vessels from Japan, the U.S.S.R., the Republic of Korea (ROK), Poland, and the People's Republic of China (PRC). Coverage by major region was 93.5% in the Bering Sea, 91.9% in the Gulf of Alaska, and 95.8% in the Washington-Oregon-California (WOC) region. Comparative coverage for 1987 was 96.4% in the Bering Sea, 99.7% in the Gulf of Alaska, and 93.9% in the WOC region. For 1988, the total fishing effort of 15,866 days was 6.9% decrease from the 1987 effort of 17,041 days.

ALASKA REGION GROUNDFISH AND INCIDENTAL CATCHES

In 1988, no groundfish resources were allocated for foreign fishing in the Bering Sea/Aleutian and Gulf of Alaska regions.

Bering Sea

(Tables 5-8)

The joint venture fishery in the Bering Sea caught 1,301,400 metric tons (t) in 1988, a 4.0% decrease from the 1987 catch of

1,355,900 t. Most of the fishing effort in 1988 occurred during the first six months of the year (85.5% of the total groundfish was taken during this period). In 1988, 131 foreign processing vessels participated in joint venture fisheries with U.S. fisherman: 52 Japanese vessels, 31 ROK vessels, 30 Soviet vessels, 13 Polish vessels, and 5 PRC vessels.

The incidental catches of prohibited species, with the exception of halibut, were less than those of 1987. The catches of 9,400 salmon, 88,000 king crab, and 3,120,900 Tanner crab represented decreases of 11.3%, 33.5%, and 54.5%, respectively. The halibut catch, however, increased by 196.7%: 1,590,700 halibut (2,579.3 t) were caught in 1988, whereas 536,200 halibut (1,472.0 t) were caught in 1987.

For 1988, the joint venture pollock quota was apportioned into two seasons: the first season was available from January 15 to April 15, and the second season available after April 15. The Bering Sea portion of the first quota was attained on February 9, resulting in the closure of the fishery until the opening of the second season on April 16. The quota for the second season was attained on May 24, closing the fishery in the Bering Sea until supplemental releases of pollock reopened the fishery on September 9, and again on November 30. The final joint venture pollock quota was reached on December 6, closing the fishery for the remainder of 1988. A separate quota for pollock in the Aleutian area was apportioned over the same two seasons as was the Bering Sea pollock quota. The first season closed on March 4 and the second season

closed on June 30. A supplemental release reopened the fishery on October 7, and the quota was reached on October 12. The joint venture yellowfin sole/flatfish fishery began on January 4. The yellowfin sole quota was reached on June 4. Fisheries for other species of flatfish (primarily rock sole, flathead sole, and Alaska plaice) continued until August 5. The yellowfin sole fishery reopened on September 9 with a supplemental release of quota, and the fishery continued through the end of 1988. In the Aleutian region, the Atka mackerel quota was reached on July 13.

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


Figure 1.--Bering Sea zones by which the restrictions on the incidental catch of king and Tanner crab apply.

Area and zone regulations implemented in 1987 through amendments to the Bering Sea/Aleutian Island Groundfish Management Plan which set catch limits for incidental catches of Chionoecetes bairdi Tanner crab, red king crab, and Pacific halibut in joint venture fisheries targeting on yellowfin sole/flatfish in the Bering Sea and Aleutian region were in effect through 1988 (see Figure 1). In addition for 1988, the U.S. participants in the joint venture yellowfin sole fishery developed a self-management system for Zones 1 and 2, which regulated bycatch rates on a joint venture company basis using industry-established rates. The scheme was adopted by NMFS and was implemented and enforced through restrictions placed on foreign vessel permits.

By zone, the total groundfish catches in fisheries targeting on yellowfin sole/flatfish were 106,400 t in Zone 1, 201,900 t in Zone 2, and 116,600 t in Zone 3. Incidental catches of <u>C. Bairdi</u> Tanner crab were 131,700 crab in Zone 1, 320,700 crab in Zone 2, and 59,600 crab in Zone 3. Incidental catches of red king crab

were 52,200 crab in Zone 1, 8,900 crab in Zone 2, and 11,700 crab in Zone 3. Incidental catches of halibut were 178,300 fish in Zone 1, 389,900 fish in Zone 2, and 66,900 fish in Zone 3.

By zone, the total groundfish catches in fisheries targeting on other species (primarily pollock and Pacific cod) were 163,800 t in Zone 1, 551,400 t in Zone 2, and 161,300 t in Zone 3. Incidental catches of <u>C. Bairdi</u> Tanner crab were 100,700 crab in Zone 1, 136,900 crab in Zone 2, and 1,100 crab in Zone 3. Incidental catches of red king crab were 8,800 crab in Zone 1, 1,000 crab in Zone 2, and less than 100 crab in Zone 3. Incidental catches of halibut were 158,400 fish in Zone 1, 739,800 fish in Zone 2, and 57,400 fish in Zone 3. Summaries of groundfish and incidentally-taken prohibited species by target fishery, zone, and subarea are included in Tables 7 and 8.

On March 8, 1988, Zone 1 was closed to the yellowfin sole/flatfish joint venture fishery due to the bycatch limit of 80,000 <u>C. bairdi</u> Tanner crab being exceeded. Zone 1 reopened on December 12 due to an increase in the bycatch limit.

Gulf of Alaska (Tables 9-10)

The joint venture fishery began operations on June 3 in the Gulf of Alaska. The fishery caught 3,800 t of groundfish in 1988, an 88.1% decrease from the 32,000 t taken in 1987. Fishing occurred in the Shumagin, Chirikof, and Kodiak subareas. The fishery targeted on flounders (however, Pacific cod constituted 47.2% of the total catch). For the year, 4 Japanese vessels and

1 ROK vessel participated in joint venture fisheries. On August 8, the fishery was closed due to the quota of 240 t of halibut being exceeded.

The incidental catches of 10,600 Tanner crab and 100 king crab represented increases from the 5,500 Tanner crab and less than 100 king crab taken during 1987. The incidental catches of 56,400 halibut (244.5 t) and 100 salmon represented decreases from the 189,800 halibut (627.8 t) and 1,000 salmon taken in 1987.

WOC REGION GROUNDFISH AND INCIDENTAL CATCHES (Tables 11-12)

The foreign fishery targeting on Pacific whiting began on June 3 and ended on October 31. The fishery caught 18,300 t of groundfish, a 63.7% decrease from the 50,400 t taken in 1987. The majority of the effort occurred in October, with 60.7% of the total catch taken during the month. The percentage of catch by the International North Pacific Fisheries Commission (INPFC) area was 93.5% in the Columbia area and 6.5% in the Eureka area. Pacific whiting comprised 98.3% of the total groundfish catch. Eighteen Polish vessels participated in the fishery.

The incidental catch of 2,200 salmon was 52.2% decrease from the 4,600 salmon taken in 1987. In 1988, 81.8% of the salmon catch occurred during October. Chinook salmon comprised 90.0% of the total salmon catch. Less than 100 halibut were taken in 1987 and 1988.

The joint venture fishery targeting on Pacific whiting began in April and ended in October. The fishery caught 136,900 t of groundfish, an increase of 27.7% from the 107,200 t taken in 1987. The percent of total catch by INPFC area was 9.2% in the Vancouver area, 71.8% in the Columbia area, 18.5% in the Eureka area, and 0.5% in the Monterrey area. Over 99% of the total catch was Pacific whiting. In 1988, 14 Polish vessels, 13 Soviet vessels, 2 ROK vessels, 1 Japanese vessel, and 1 PRC vessel participated in joint venture fisheries.

The incidental catch of 14,000 salmon was a 62.8% increase from the 8,600 salmon taken in 1987. For 1988, 80.0% of the total salmon catch occurred during July and August (only 55.4% of the total groundfish was taken during these two months). Of the total salmon catch, 80.0% were chinook. The incidental catch of halibut was about 100 fish. Less than 100 halibut were taken in 1987.
