
- Beach nourishment (placing sand on an eroding beach)

Ohio State Drought Plan

Phases determine actions:

- 1. Normal Conditions
- 2. Drought Alert monitor situation
- 3. Conservation Phase can enact voluntary water conservation measures
- 4. Drought Emergency can enact mandatory restrictions on water use
