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

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

Please note, however, that some shellfish commissions follow the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection standard which states that a senior citizen is anyone 65 years of age or older and others define seniors as age 62 or older.

Special fees apply to minors:

Most shellfish commissions consider anyone 12 years of age and younger eligible for a lower fee. In some cases, commissions consider anyone 16 years of age and younger a minor.



MAPS OF TOWN SHELLFISH GROUNDS






MAP OF RECREATIONAL SHELLFISHING AREA







NOTE: Regulated recreational shalltshing is permitted in Approved and Conditionally Approved (numbered 1-5) areas only ALL OTHER AREAS (including Sachems Head Harbor) ARE CLOSED TO RECREATIONAL SHELLFISHING! (see map) or call 453-8088. Shellishing permits are required and can be purchased at the Guilford Town Clerk's Office or Police Station. To facilitate patrolling fishermen are requested to leave permits on the dashboard of their vehicles.


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


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
