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MONROE COUNTY: AN ECONOMIC OVERVIEW

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Abstract

Available secondary data were compiled and assimilated to describe a variety of economic and social characteristics of Monroe County. Data were obtained from a number of sources, both from county and state agencies. Data are related to population, income, employment, unemployment, retail sales, tourism development tax proceeds, and commercial and recreational fishing activities. Data are presented for major economic sectors of the local economy, and more detailed data are presented for the service and retail sales sectors due to their relative importance.

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INTRODUCTION

Monroe County, located at Florida's southern tip and consisting mostly of the Florida Keys, represents an area that is unique in terms of location, in terms of environmental-ecological features, and in terms of the economic activity supported by the unique combination of local resources. The area is dependent on tourism, the local economy is highly seasonal in nature, and local/state concerns over environmental impacts raise serious questions about the future development of the area. In this respect, Monroe County differs from the State of Florida in that seasonality patterns are more marked, the tourism dependence is more pronounced, and environmental concerns are more pressing.

In order to provide more insight into the unique aspects of economic activity in Monroe County, this report offers an overview of the Monroe County economy. Following sections present detailed information on population, employment, taxable and gross sales, and commercial and recreational fishing. Tourism development tax proceeds are examined in order to assess both the growth and seasonality of tourism activity. Data are presented for major economic sectors of the local economy, and more detailed data are presented for the service and retail sales components due to their importance in terms of local employment. All data are from secondary sources, and Appendix 5 provides a detailed listing of data sources for those interested in studying the local area in more detail.

POPULATION AND INCOME

Population: Monroe County population data are reported in Table P1. Total population has increased from 30,000 people in 1950 to 78,024 in 1990. The estimated population for 1992 is 80,968. The table also reports population for Florida and Monroe County as a percent of Florida's total population. Since 1950, Monroe County population growth has been less than that for the state as a whole. As a result, Monroe County as a percent of total the total state population has declined from over one percent in 1950 to only 0.60 percent in 1992.

Table P1 also reflects the age distribution of Monroe County population for the 1980 and 1990 census years and for 1992. Over this period, the percentage of the population in the 15-24 year old age group declined from more than 16 percent of total population to less than 10 percent. Age groups showing increases include the 25-44 year old age group and the 65 and over age group. The former contained slightly over 34 percent of the population in 1992 while the latter was slightly over 16 percent.

In general, population growth in Monroe County has been slower than that for the state as a whole. Further, population projections indicate that this trend is expected to continue in the future. Monroe County is projected to have slightly over 110,00 people by the year 2020, roughly 0.55 percent of Florida's population.

Income: Detailed information on personal income for Monroe County by source is reported in Appendix 1 and summarized in Tables I1 and I2 at five year intervals beginning in 1970. Similar data are presented in Appendix 1 for Florida for those interested in comparing the county to the state.

Income data confirm the importance of trade and service sectors as providers of income

and employment in Monroe County. However, as will be noted in a later section, the dominance of the trade and service sectors is less marked in income than in employment. This is due to the relatively large percentage of income generated by dividends, interest, rent, and by transfer payments. These categories in 1991 provided over 50 percent of total personal income in Monroe County, reflecting the importance of investment income and retirement income to the county economy.

On a per capita basis, Monroe County income exceeds that for the state of Florida and has since the mid-1980's (Figure I1). Monroe County per capita income in 1991 stood at \$20,332 per year compared to \$18,985 for the state.

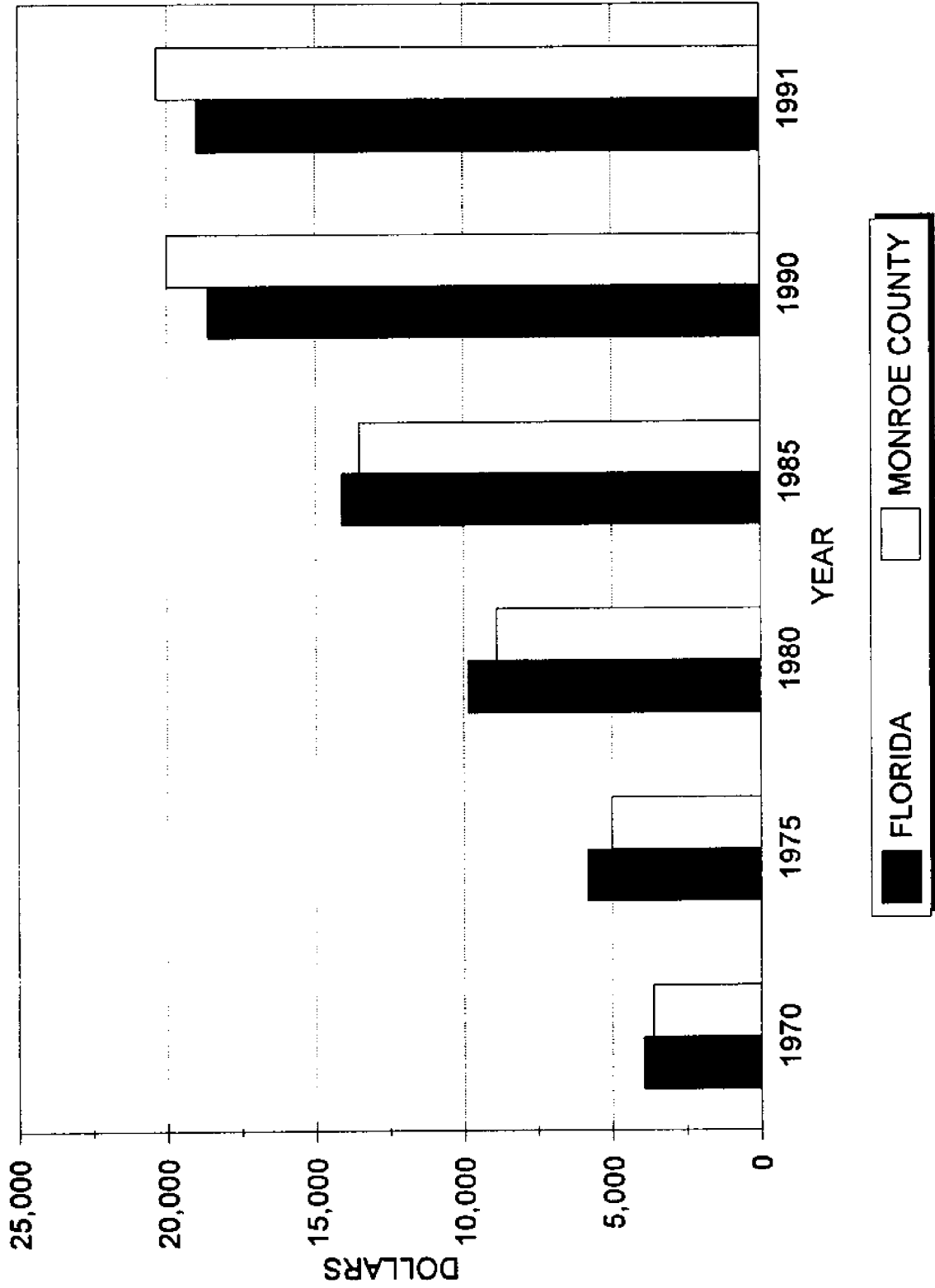

EMPLOYMENT AND UNEMPLOYMENT

Data on employment and unemployment for Monroe County are presented in detail in Appendix 2. These data are from the Florida Department of Labor and Employment Security and reflect monthly reporting of employment by economic sector from 1989 through the first quarter of 1993. Unemployment data are reported monthly from 1989 through 1993.

Employment data are summarized in Tables E1-E5, and unemployment data are presented in Tables E6-E8. Taken together, these data reflect the seasonal nature of economic activity in Monroe county and the dependence of the local economy on tourism related sectors.

Employment: Table E1 presents total employment by month for the period 1989-1992, and average monthly employment by sector for the same period is reported by sector in Table E2. The percentage of employment by sector is reported in Table E3. For the most recent full year, 1992, total employment ranged from a low of 28,374 in September to a high of 30,764 in May. Data are reflected graphically in Figures E1-E4. There is some variation from year to year, but the general trends are similar. Employment is seasonal with the peak numbers occurring in the December-March period and the lowest employment levels occurring in the September-October period. On average, total employment (Table E2) reflects very little change over the 1989-1992 period.

Table E3 reflects the dominance of the retail trade sector and the services sector as the primary sources of employment in Monroe County. Each of these sectors accounted for over 31 percent of total employment in 1991 and 1992. Further, this pattern showed little tendency to change over the 1989-1992 period. Because of the dominance of retail and service sectors, Tables E4 and E5 present more detailed data for these two sectors. Both, on average, provide around 9,300 to 9,400 jobs, and both show slight increases over the 1989-1992 period.

Within the retail trade sector, the dominant employer is the eating and drinking places subsector. This subsector provides over 47 percent of total retail sector employment. Other major subsectors within retail employment are grocery stores and miscellaneous retail stores. These two subsectors each provide 14 to 15 percent of total retail sector employment.

A similar concentration of employment is reflected within the services sector. Here more than 43 percent of employment is provided by hotels and other lodging places. The other major service subsector is health services which provides more than 19 percent of service sector employment. Graphically, (Figures E5-E8) retail sector and service sector employment exhibit patterns similar to those indicated above for total county employment. Again, employment data for the economy as a whole and for the retail trade and service sectors reflect a seasonal employment pattern dependent on tourism related businesses.

Unemployment: Data on the size of the labor force, the number of unemployed workers, and the unemployment rate for the 1990-1993 period are presented in Table E6. The relatively low unemployment rate (3.3 percent) in 1990 increased to 5.3 percent by 1992 and has since decreased. In 1993 there were 1,759 unemployed workers. The monthly rate of unemployment is reported for the same period in Table E7, and Table E8 reports the number of unemployed workers by month.

Data on unemployed workers and the unemployment rate are reported graphically in Figures E9-E12 for 1992-93. Again, these data exhibit a similar pattern to that of employment reported earlier. Unemployment, as expected, moves opposite to the employment trends noted earlier, it is higher during the summer months, the slower time for the tourist season.

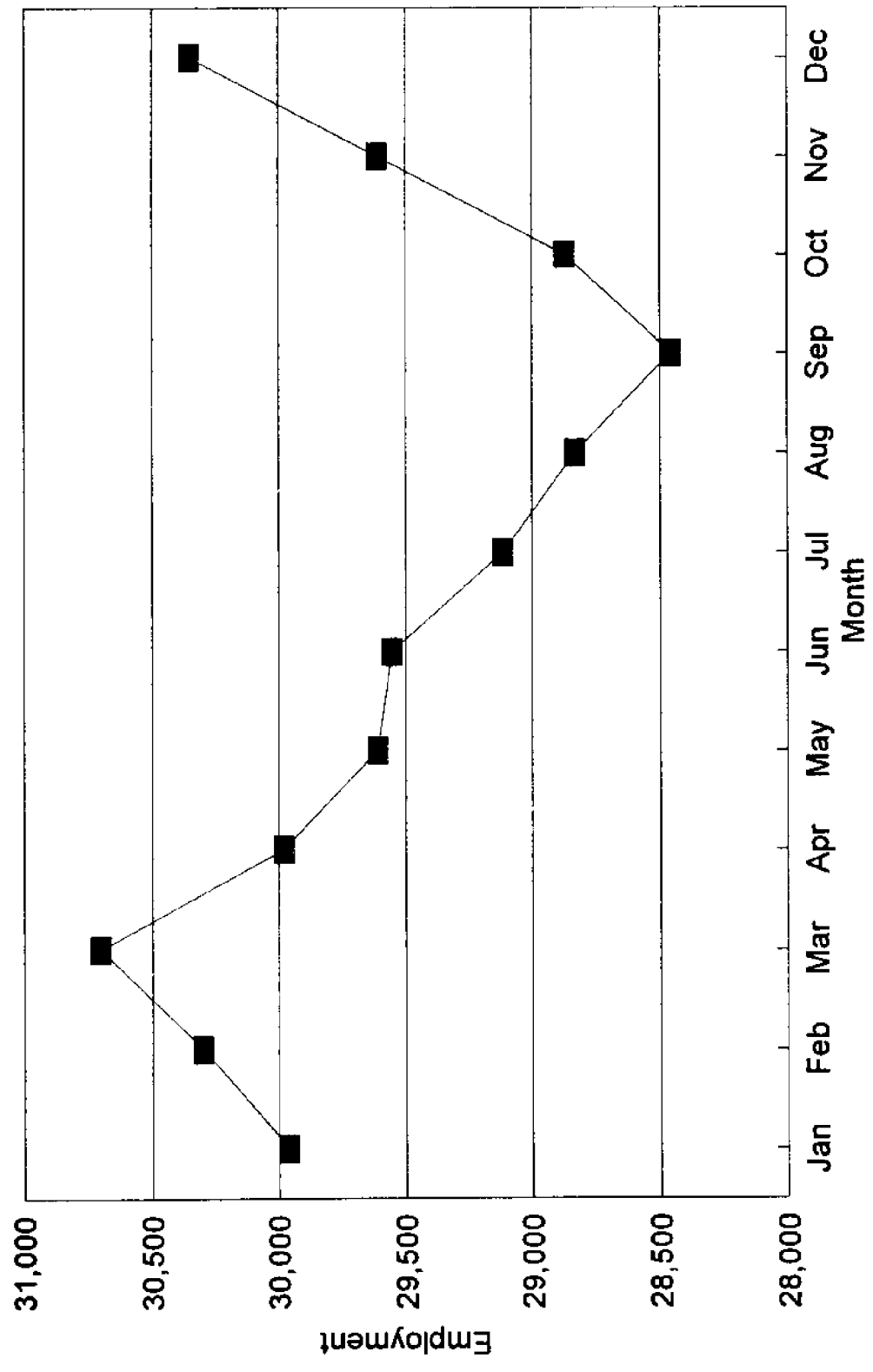

MONTHLY EMPLOYMENT MONROE COUNTY 1990

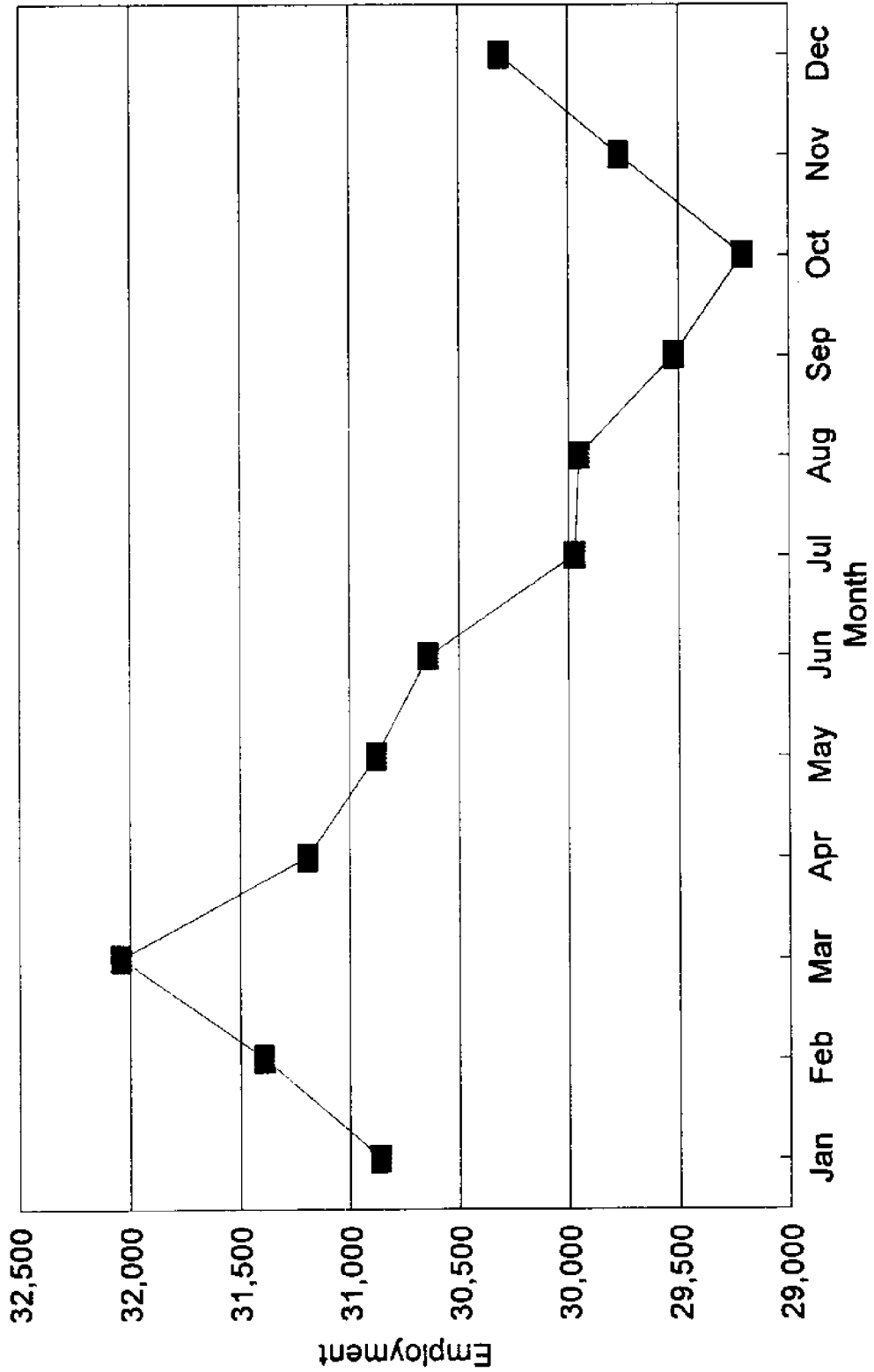

MONTHLY EMPLOYMENT MONROE COUNTY 1991

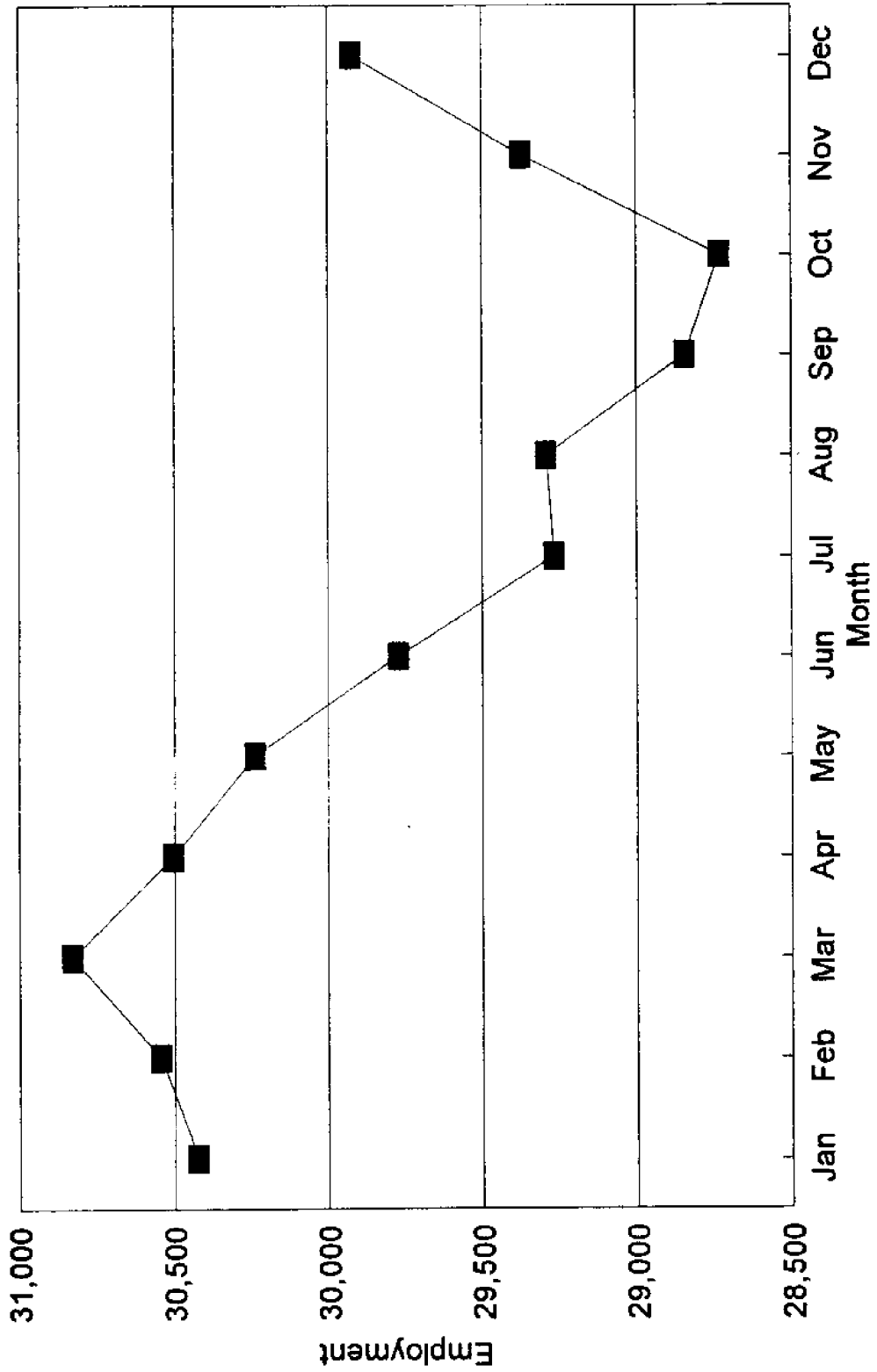
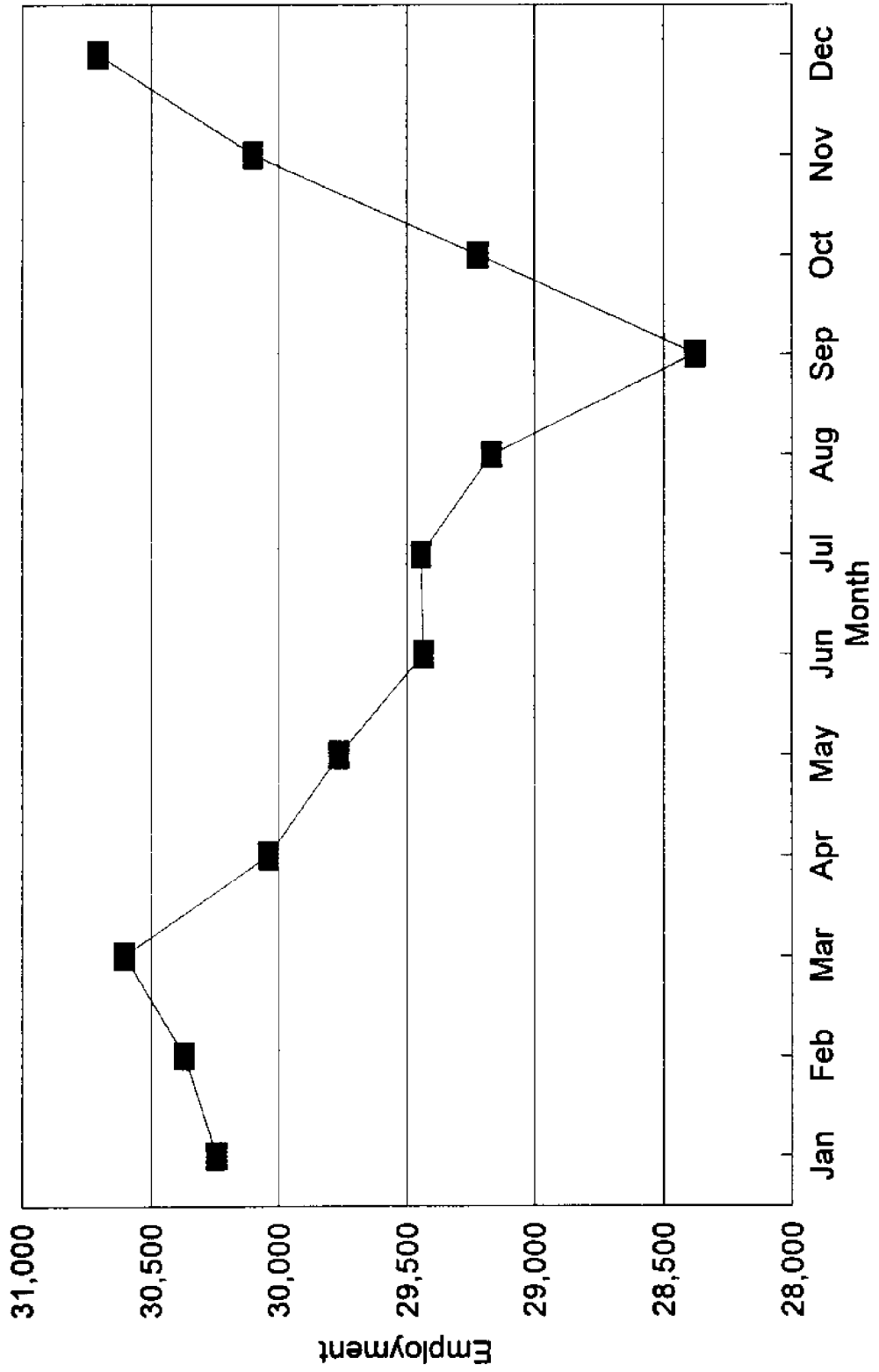

RETAIL TRADE AND SERVICE EMPLOYMENT MONROE COUNTY: 1989

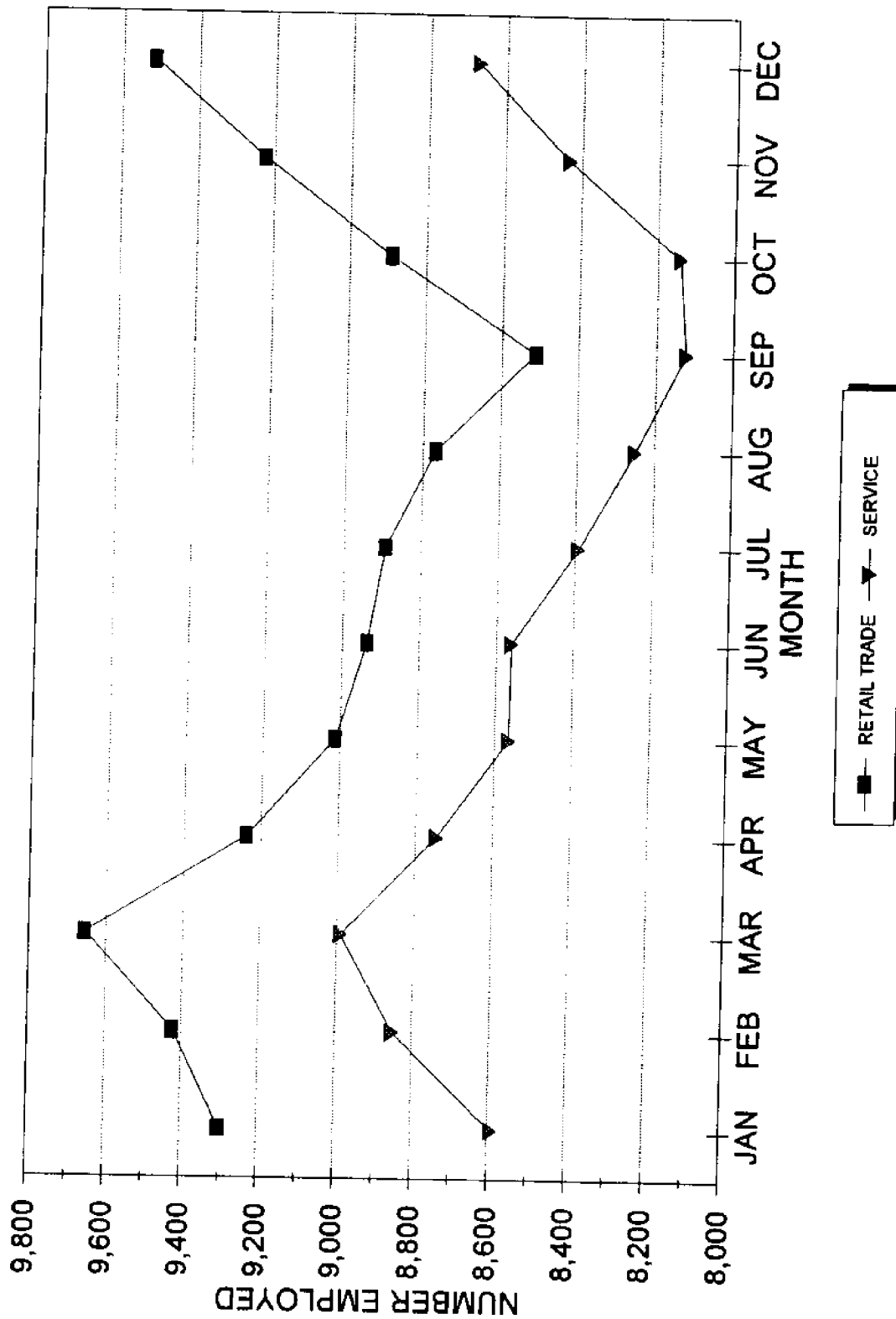

RETAIL TRADE AND SERVICE EMPLOYMENT MONROE COUNTY: 1990

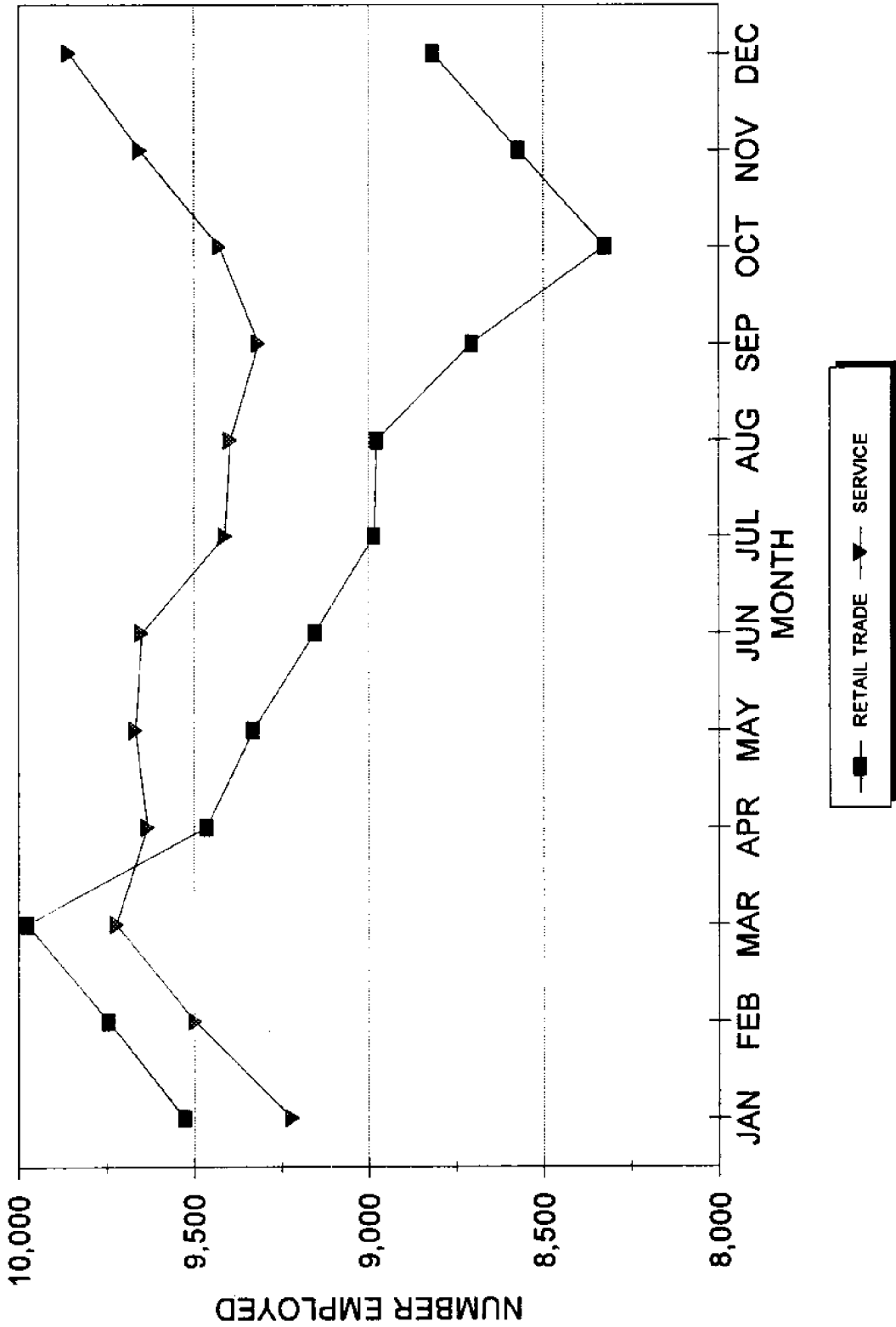

RETAIL TRADE AND SERVICE EMPLOYMENT MONROE COUNTY: 1991

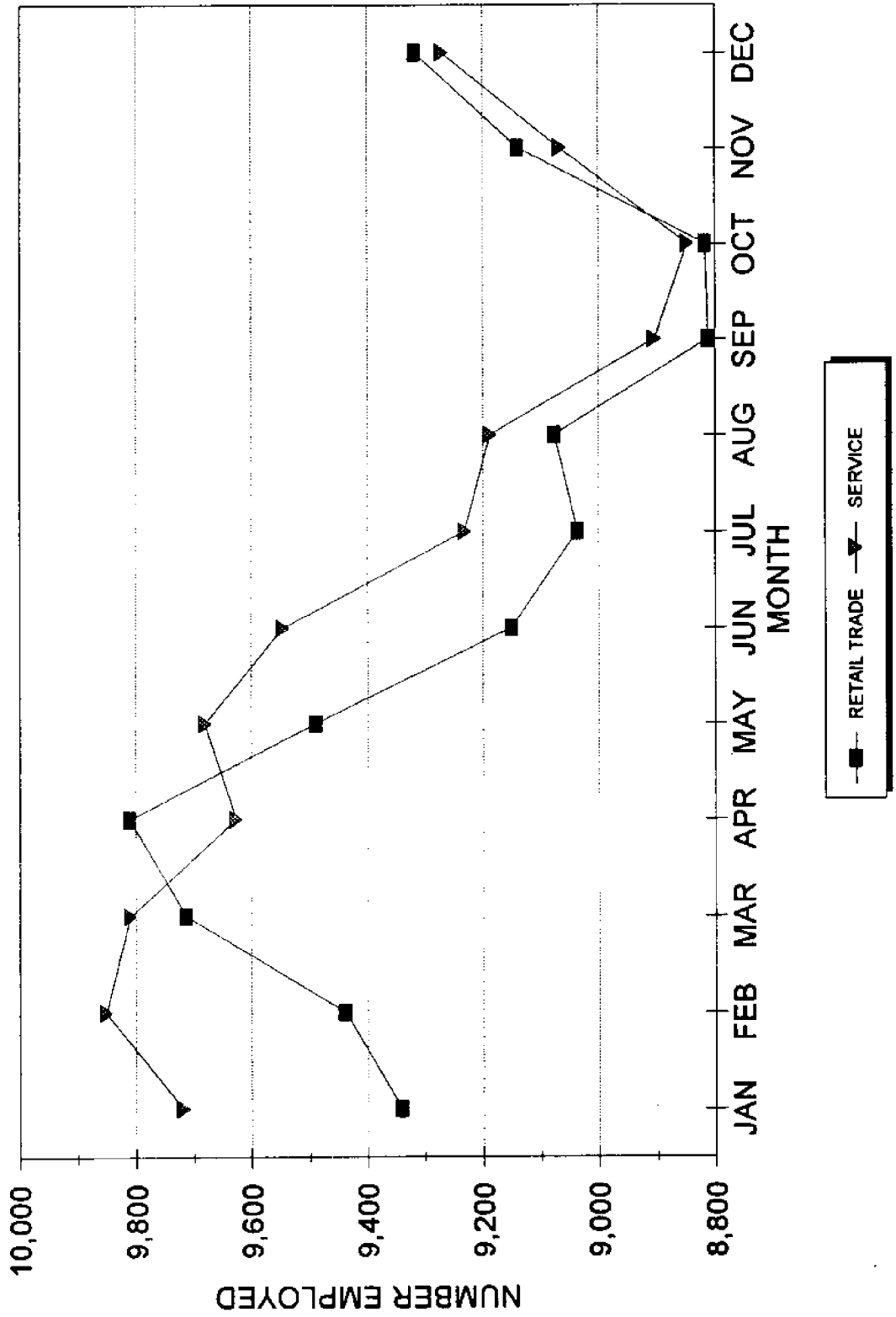
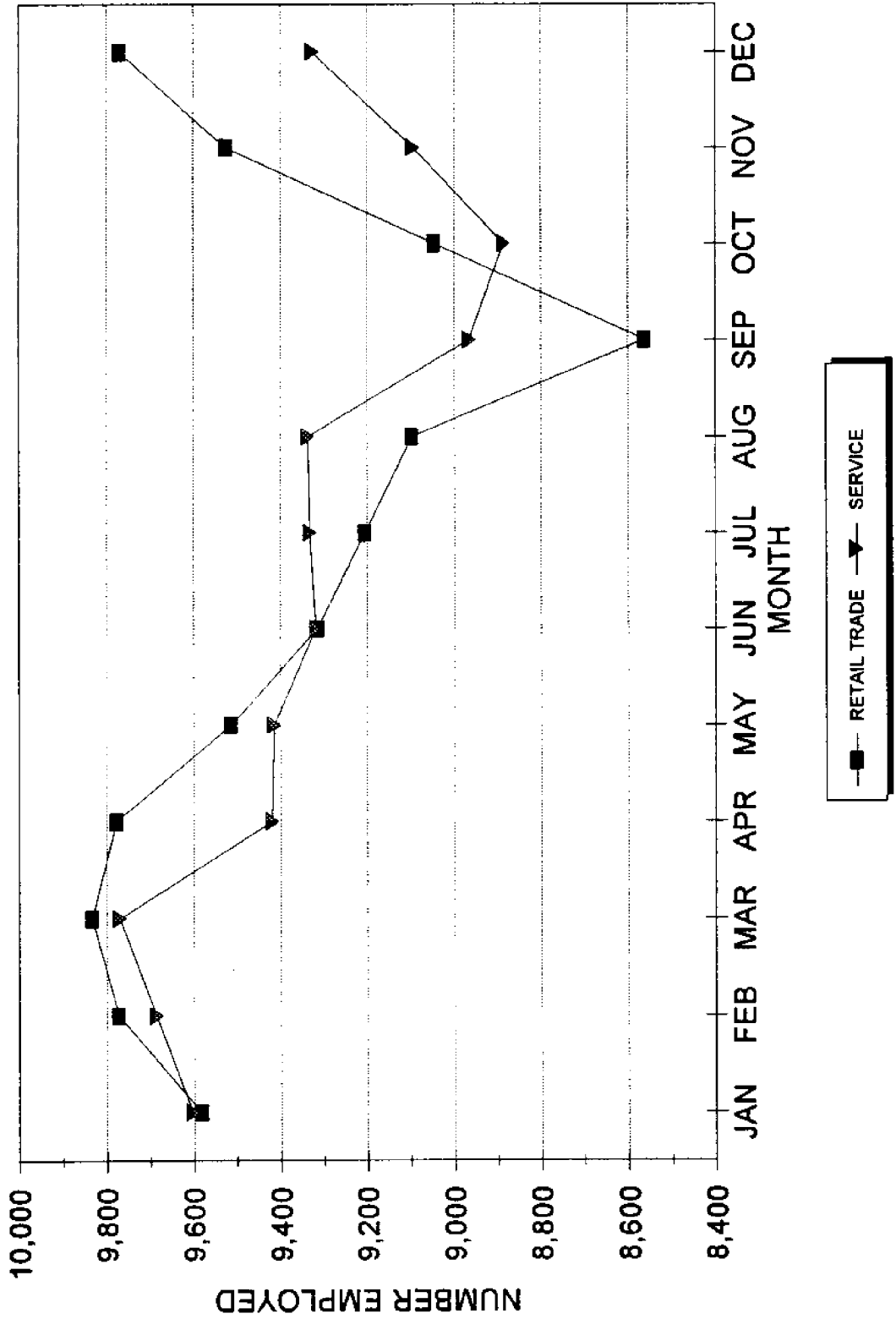

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE MONROE COUNTY 1992

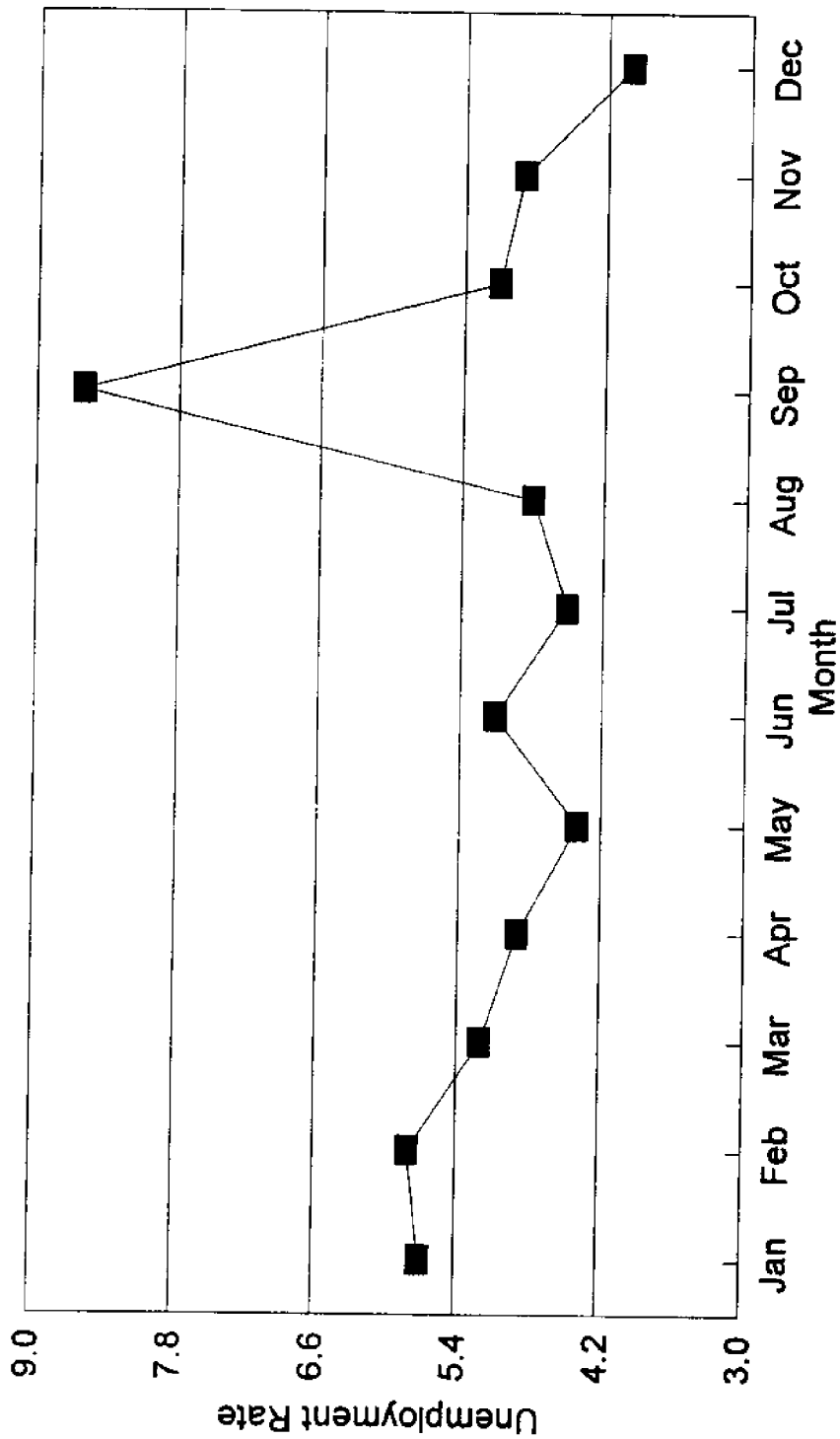

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE MONROE COUNTY 1993

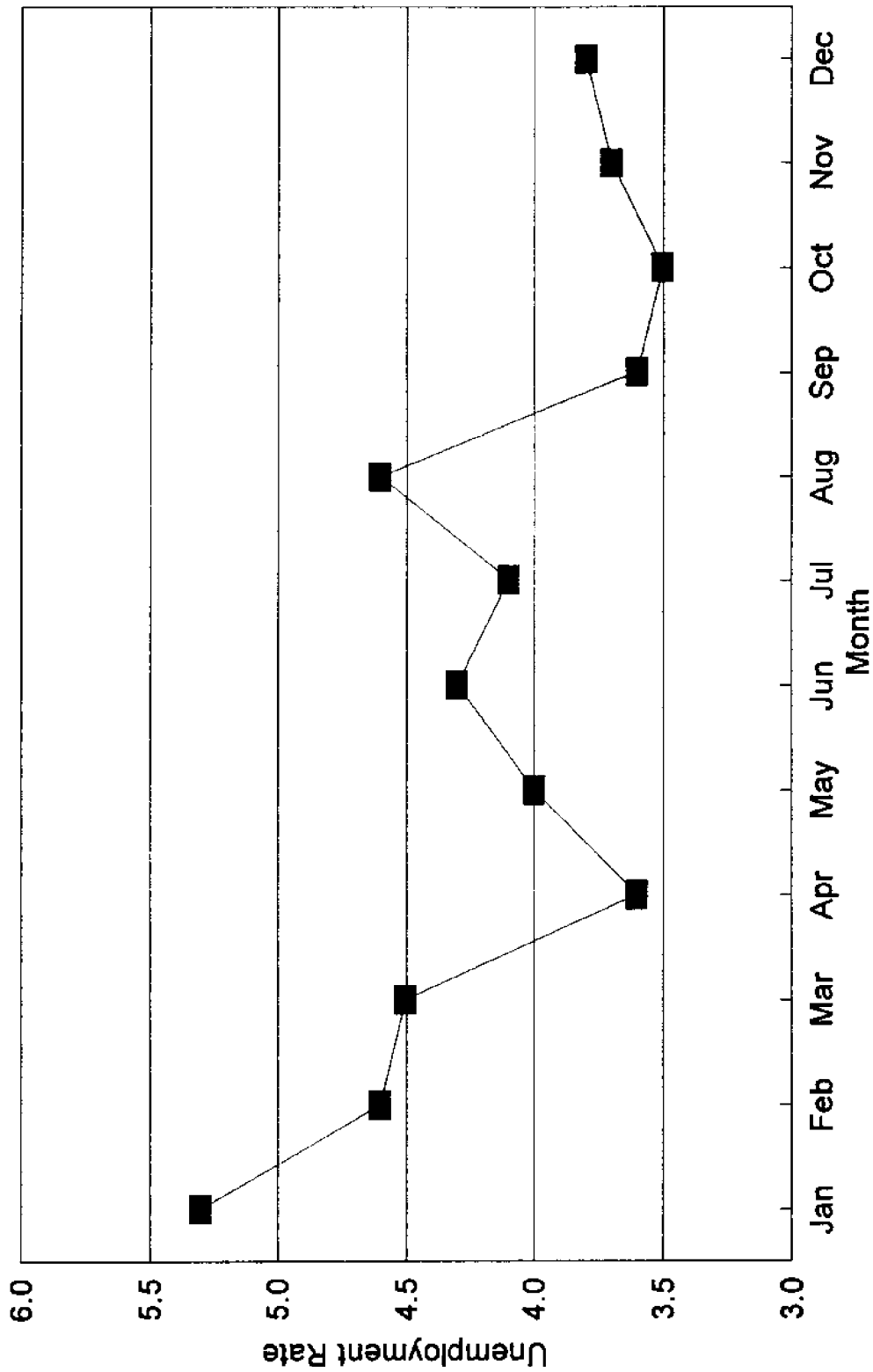

UNEMPLOYED WORKERS MONROE COUNTY 1992

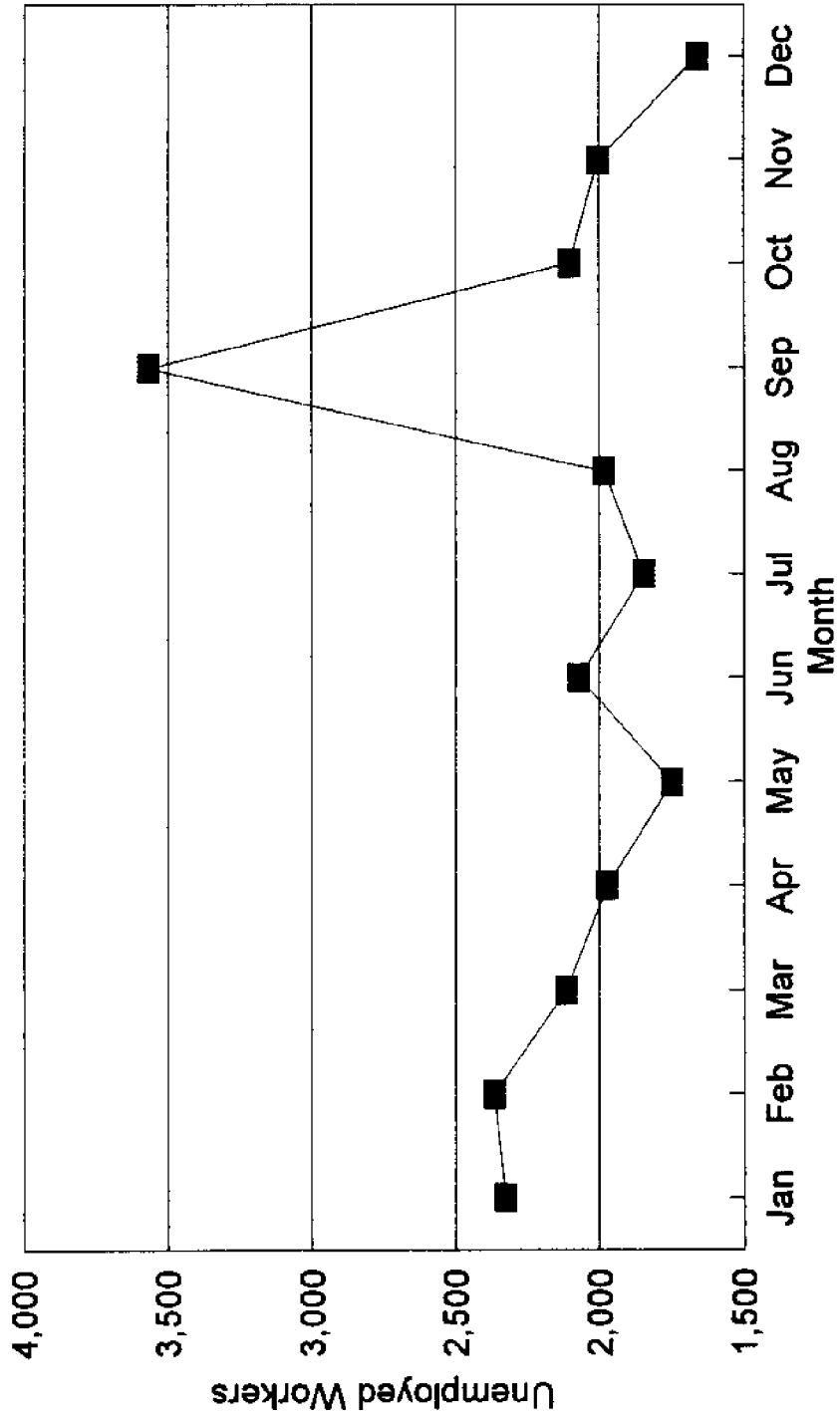

UNEMPLOYED WORKERS MONROE COUNTY 1993

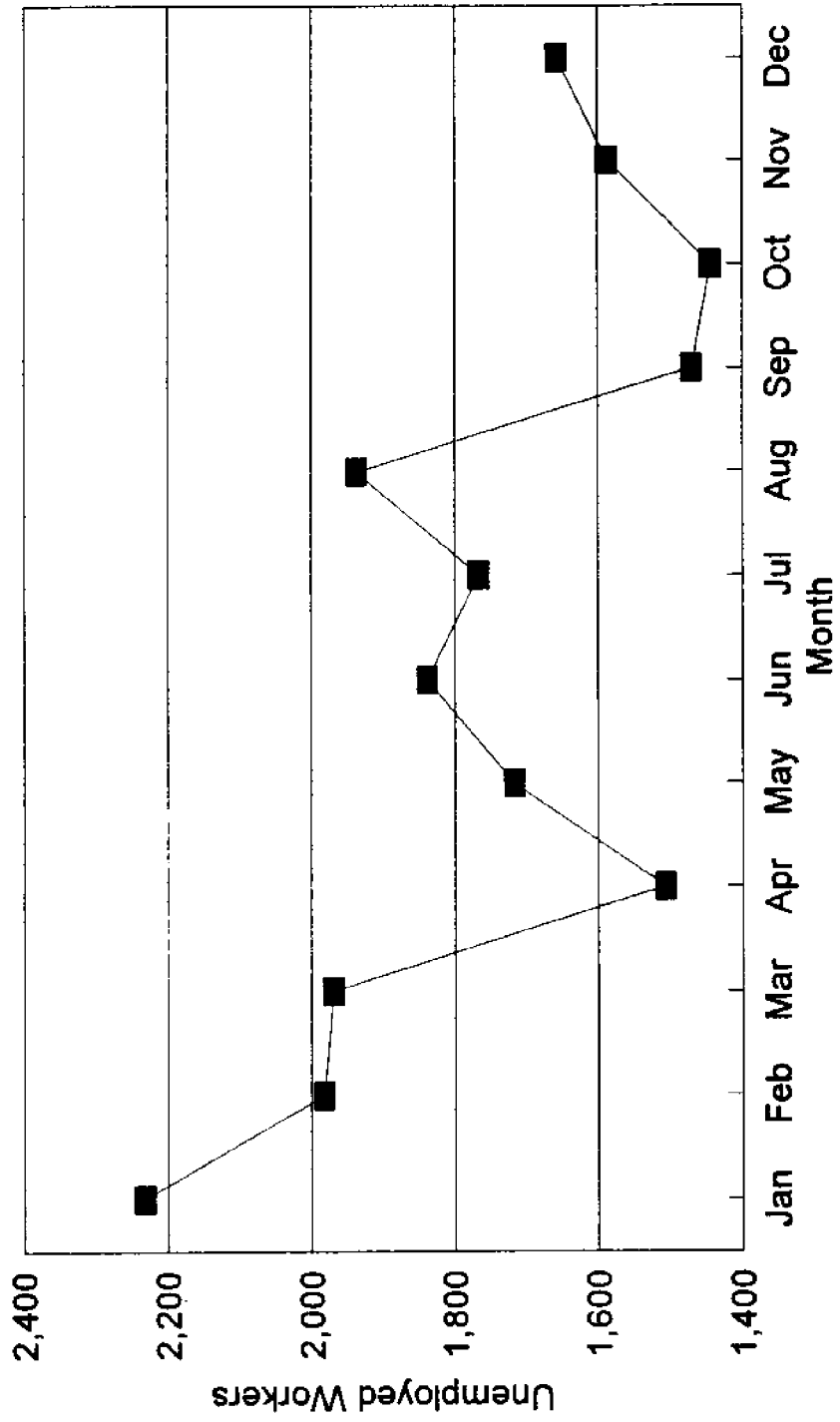

MONROE COUNTY: TAXABLE SALES BY YEAR

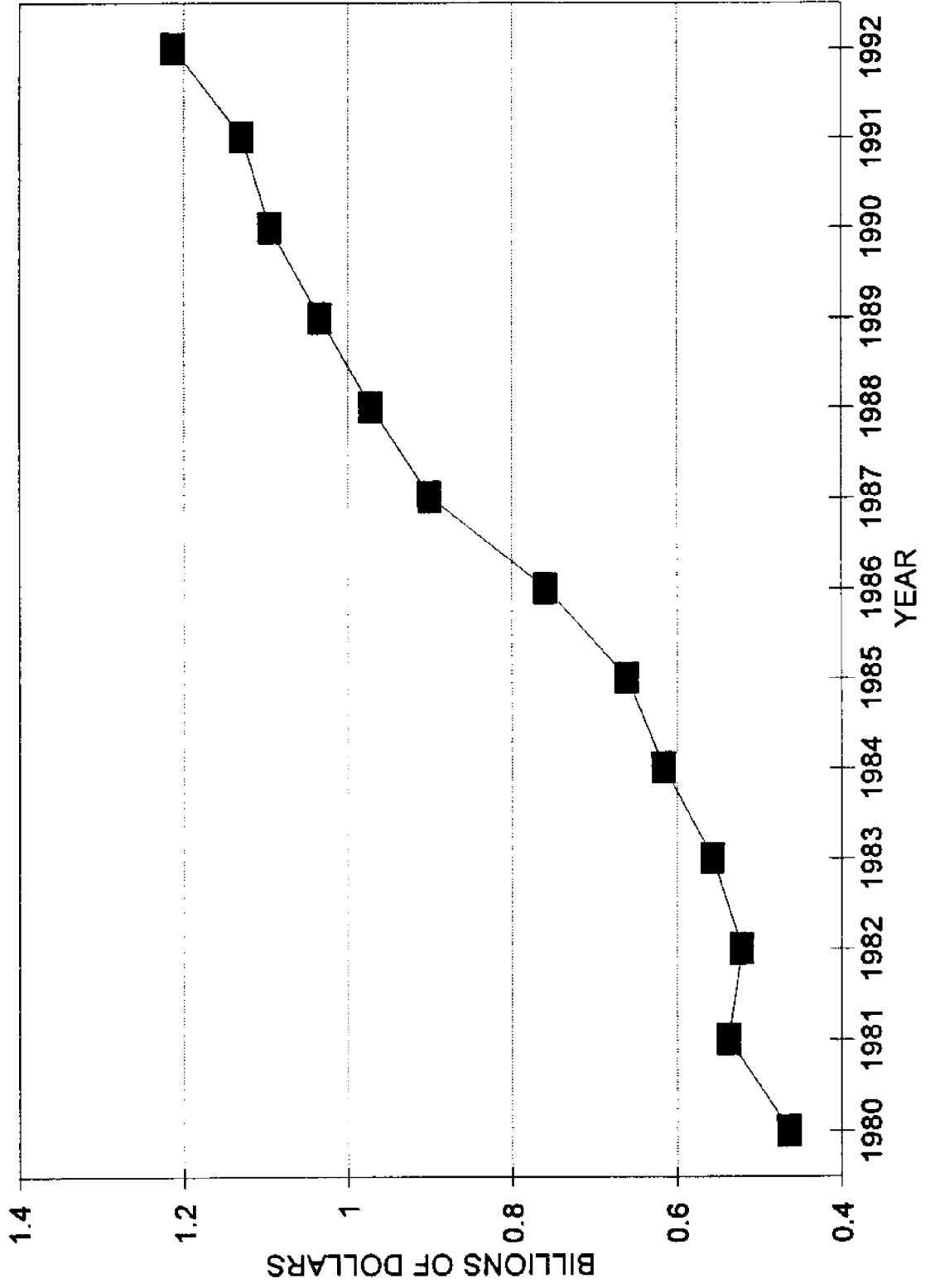
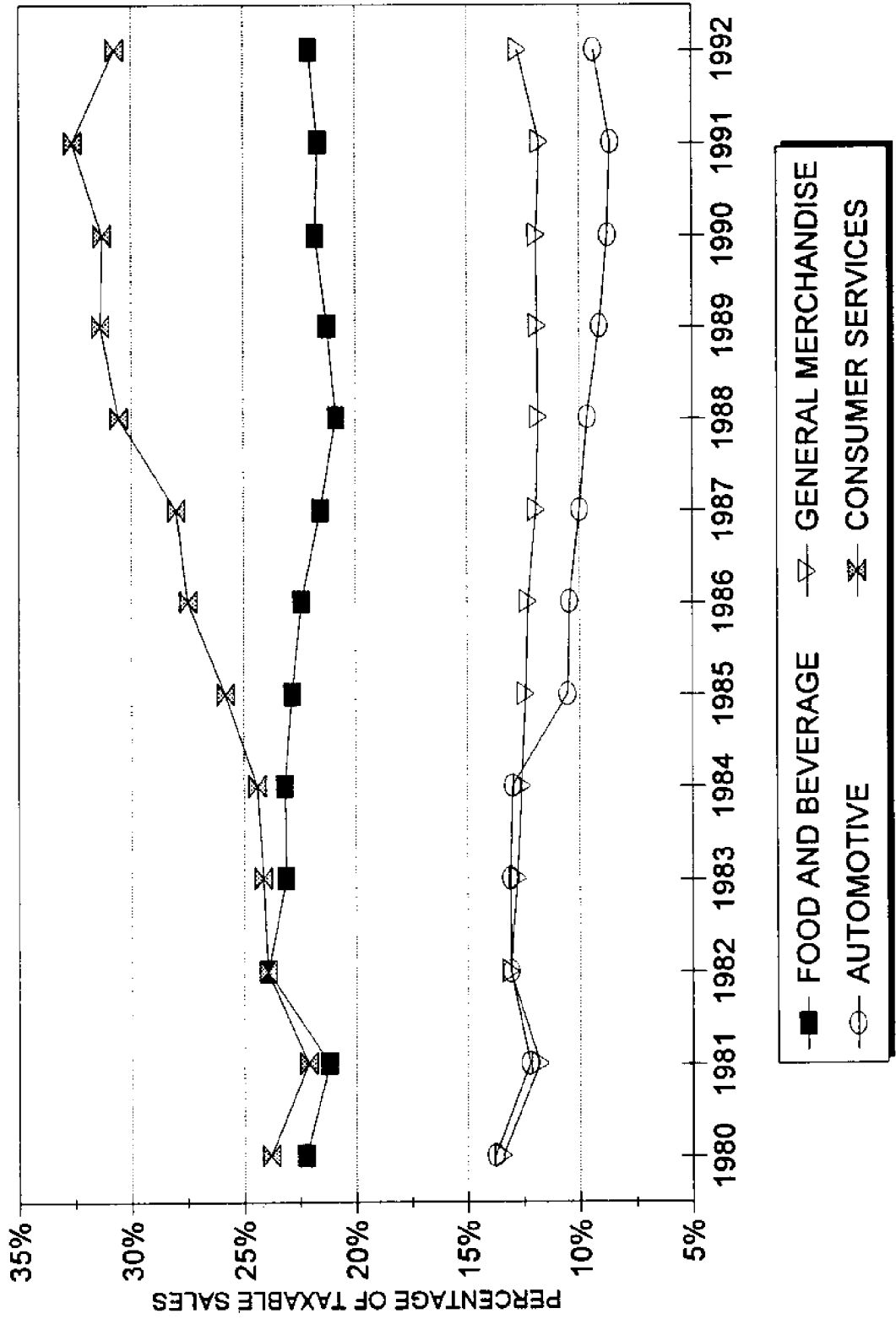

GROSS SALES MONROE COUNTY: 1992

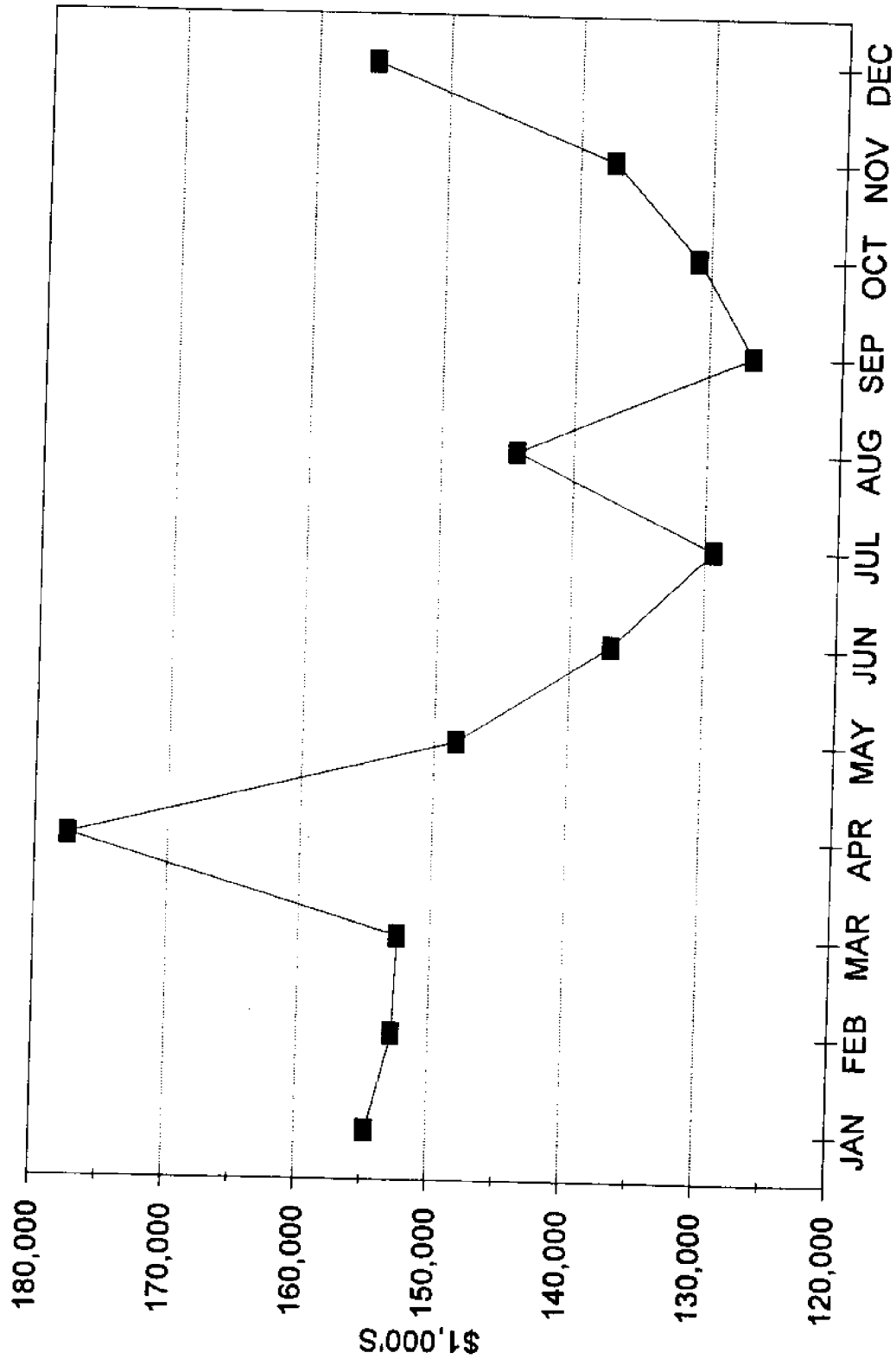
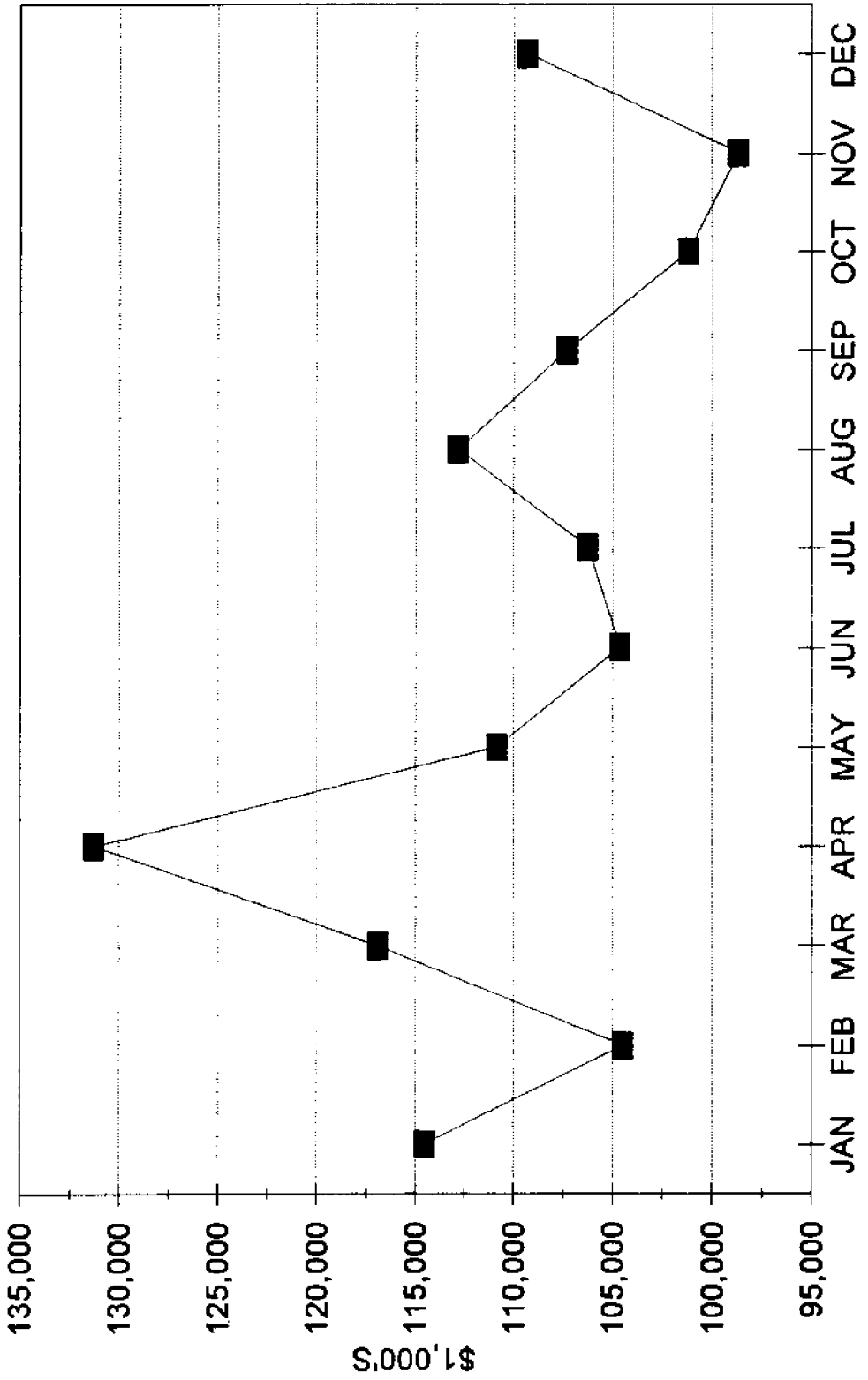

TAXABLE SALES MONROE COUNTY 1992

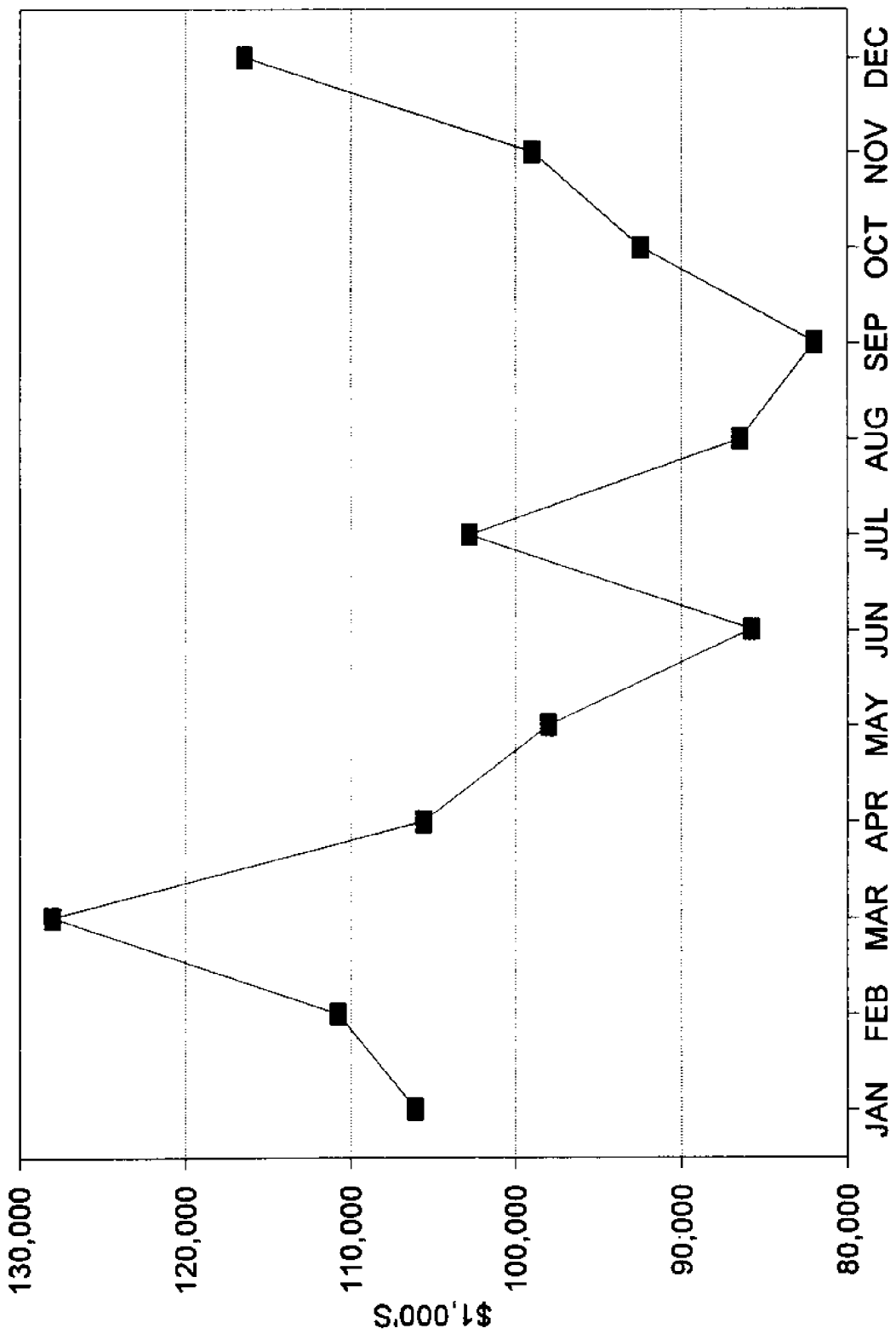
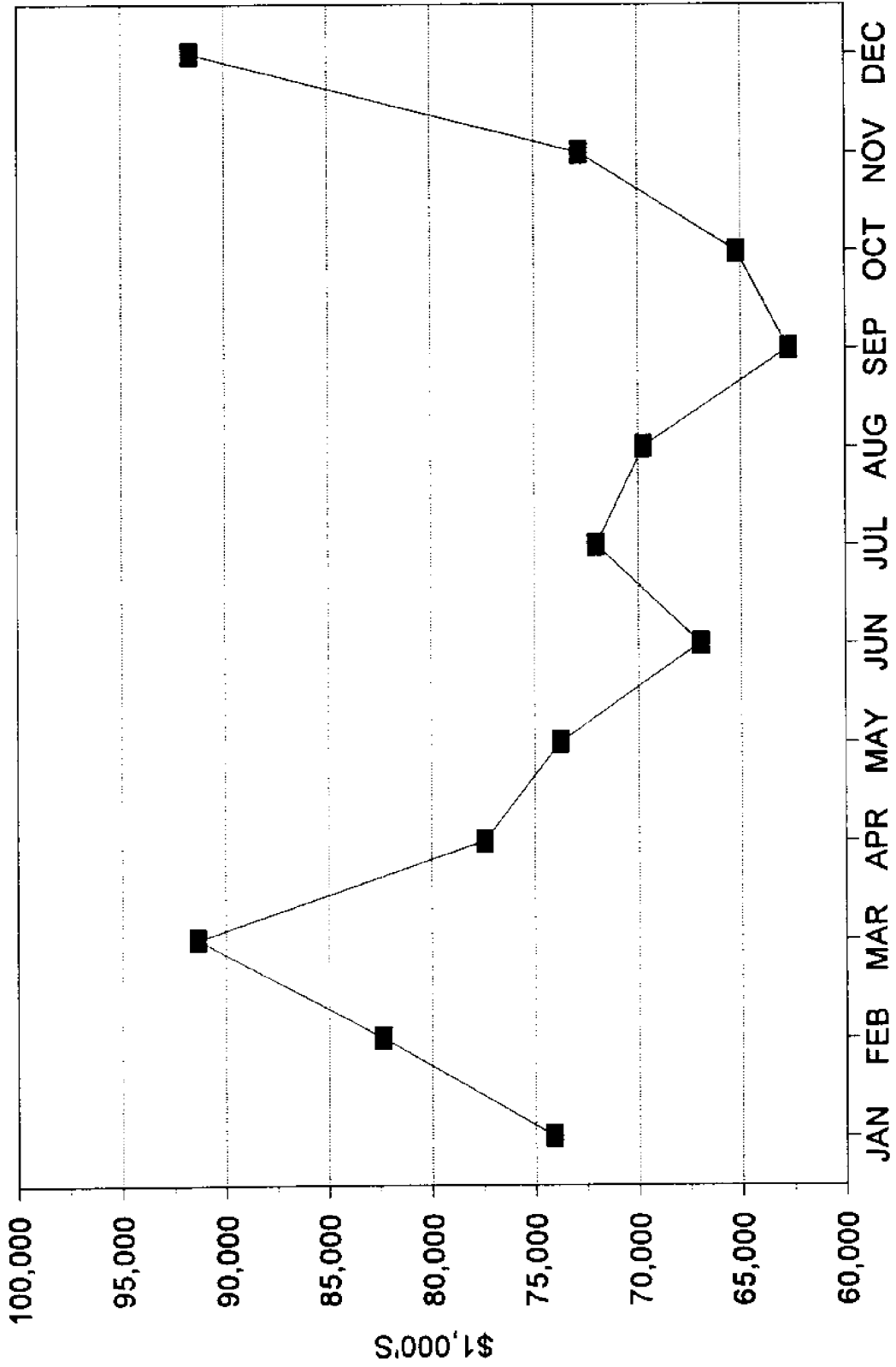

RETAIL SALES

Another measure of economic activity in a tourism dependent economy such as Monroe County is retail sales. Appendix 3 provides detail on total sales and taxable sales in Monroe County, by month and by general type of good sold, for the period 1980-1990.³ Data are summarized for purposes of discussion in Tables S1-S5 and Figures S1-S6.

Total Sales: Total sales by sub-sector within the retail sales group is reported in Table S1 for 1982 and 1992. The table also reflects the percentage change in sales over the 1982-92 period. Total sales increased from \$719 million to more than \$1.7 billion over the ten year period, an increase of 142 percent. Within the sub-groups, the largest sales increases were in apparel, an increase of more than 300 percent, and in consumer services and speciality retail, each of which increased by more than 200 percent. Other sub-groups increasing more than the overall rate include general merchandise, other services, and wholesale dealers.

Table S2 shows total sales for each year over the 1980-1992 period, and Table S3 shows the percentage of total sales contributed by each sector in each year. Comparisons between years allow an assessment of the changing relative importance of sub-groups over time. Sectors declining in relative importance include food and beverages, from 26.25 percent to 24.02 percent, and automotive sales which declined from 16.95 percent in 1990 to only 11.60 percent of total sales in 1992. Sectors gaining in relative importance include general merchandise, a slight increase, and consumer services which increased from 18.24 percent of total sales in 1980 to almost 25 percent of total sales in 1992.

Taxable Sales: Data similar to that above on taxable sales by sector are reported in

Tables S4-S5. Taxable sales increased by more than 161 percent over the 1980-1992 period, slightly more than the increase in total sales over the same period. Taxable sales totaled slightly over \$101 million in 1992. The large difference between the two, to a large extent, reflects the importance of the services sector in Monroe County. The two service categories together account for more than \$560 million dollars in total sales, most of which is exempt from sales tax. Still, the sector showing the largest increase in relative importance as a contributor of taxable sales was consumer services. Most other sectors declined in relative importance over the 1980-1992 period. The growth in taxable sales and the percentage contribution of the four larger sectors are reflected graphically in Figure S1-S2.

Total sales and taxable sales by month for selected years are reported graphically in Figures S3-S6. These data exhibit patterns similar to that of the employment data reported earlier. They reflect a seasonal economy with a low point in late summer months and a peak during the late winter tourist season. Both total sales and taxable sales exhibit similar patterns.

TOURISM DEVELOPMENT TAX PROCEEDS

Another indication of the seasonal nature of the Monroe County economy is offered by tracking proceeds of the tourism development tax. Appendix 4 provides information on tax proceeds by month for the period 1984 - 1992. Data are presented for total tax proceeds and for each of the five districts in the county. Data are then reported in summary form in Table TDTP1 and Figures TDTP 1-12.

Table TDTP1 shows tax proceeds and the percentage of total by region for selected years from 1984 - 1992. Over this period, total tax proceeds increased from \$1.16 million to almost \$4.4 million. District I generates slightly over one-half of tax revenues. Revenue growth for total proceeds by District are shown in Figures TDTP 1-6. All districts exhibit similar growth patterns over the early part of the period. Total proceeds were level between 1990 and 1991 and proceeds declined in Districts II and IV between 1990 and 1991. In all districts, 1992 tax proceeds were above those for 1991.

The seasonality of the tourism industry is reflected in monthly tax proceeds. Figures TDTP 7 - 12 reflect monthly collections for each district in 1992. Patterns are similar to those for employment and retail sales. The economy peaks in the late winter tourism season and reaches a low point in late summer months

TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX PROCEEDS TOTAL ALL DISTRICTS

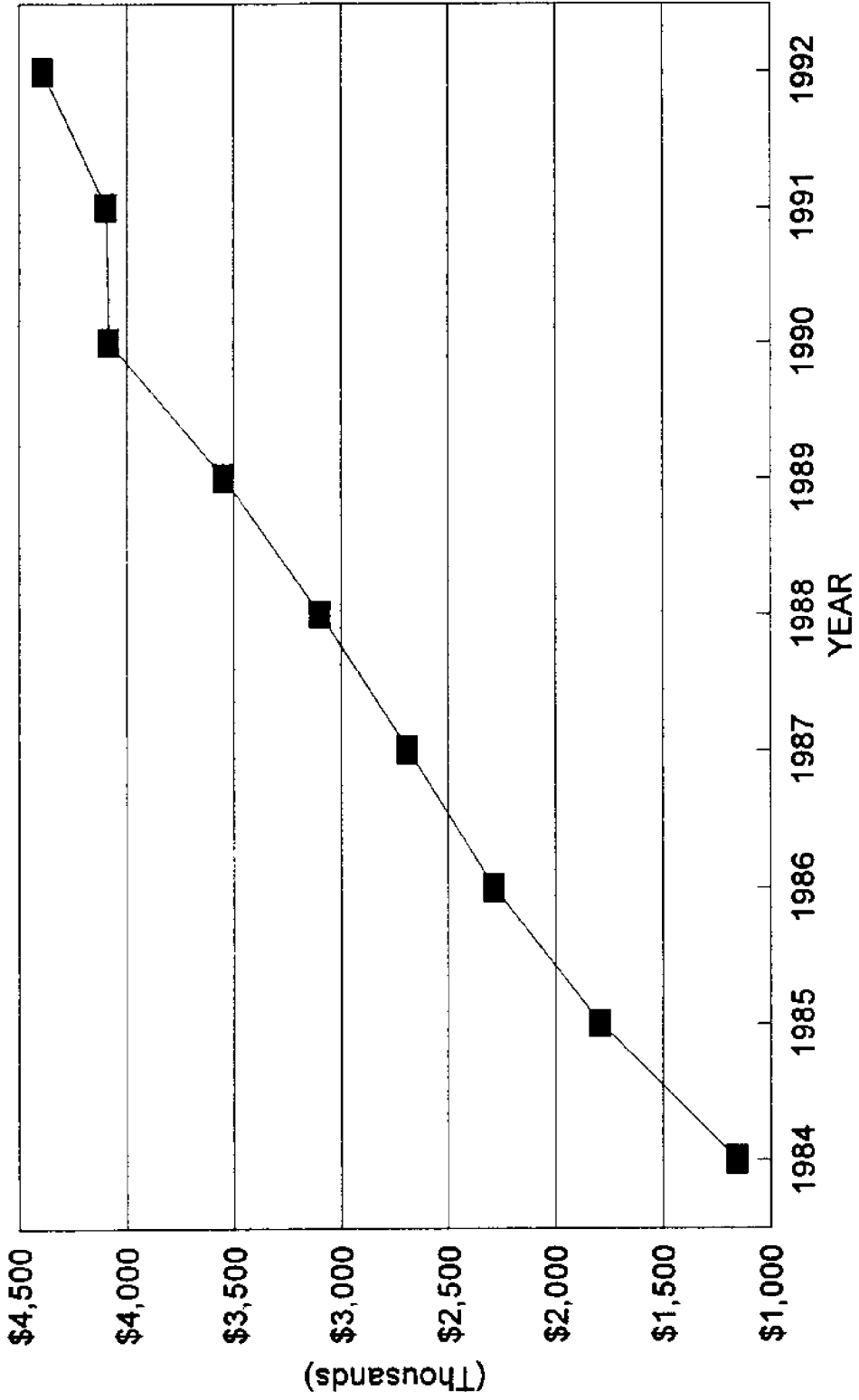

TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX PROCEEDS TOTAL DISTRICT I

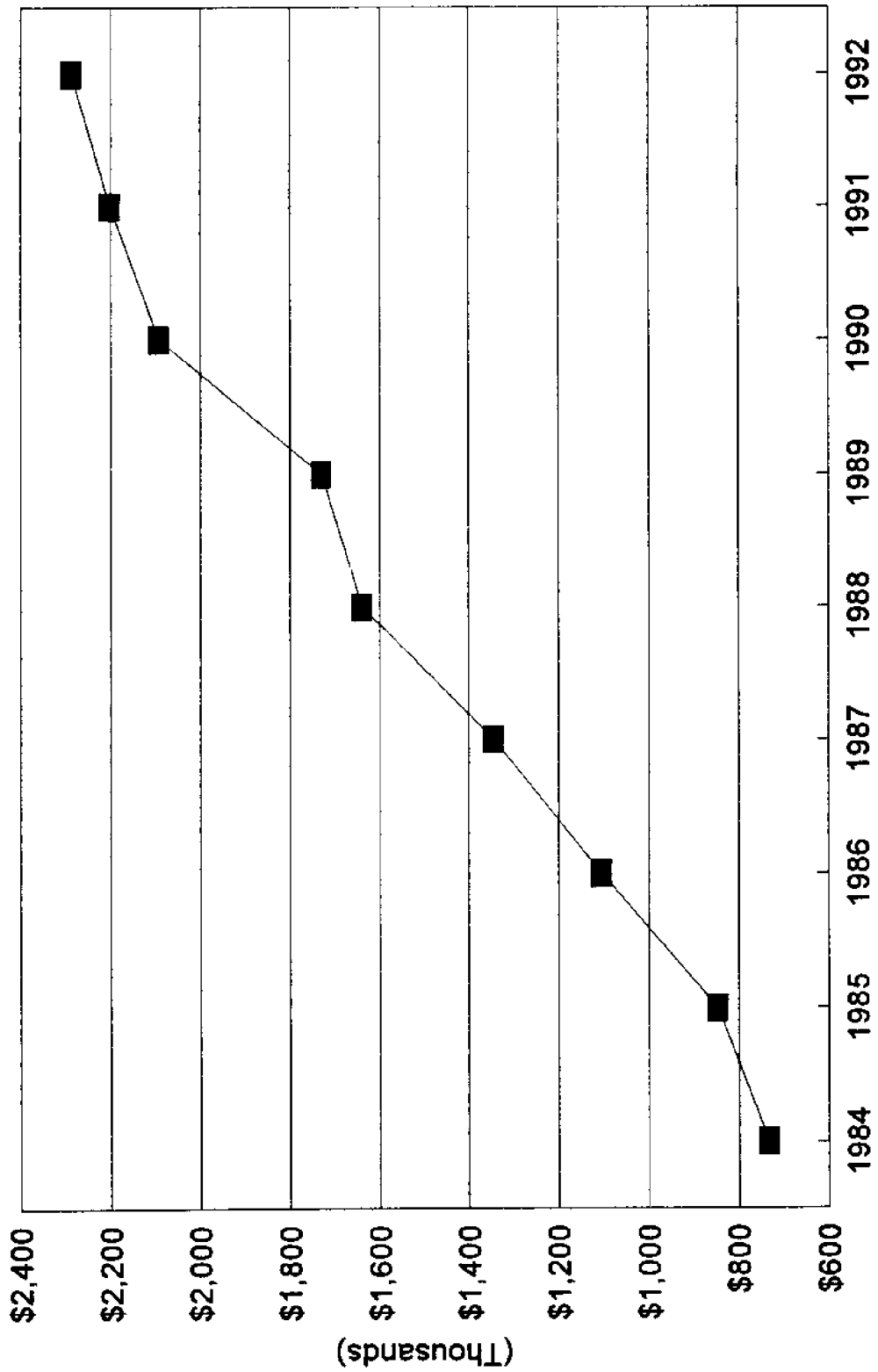
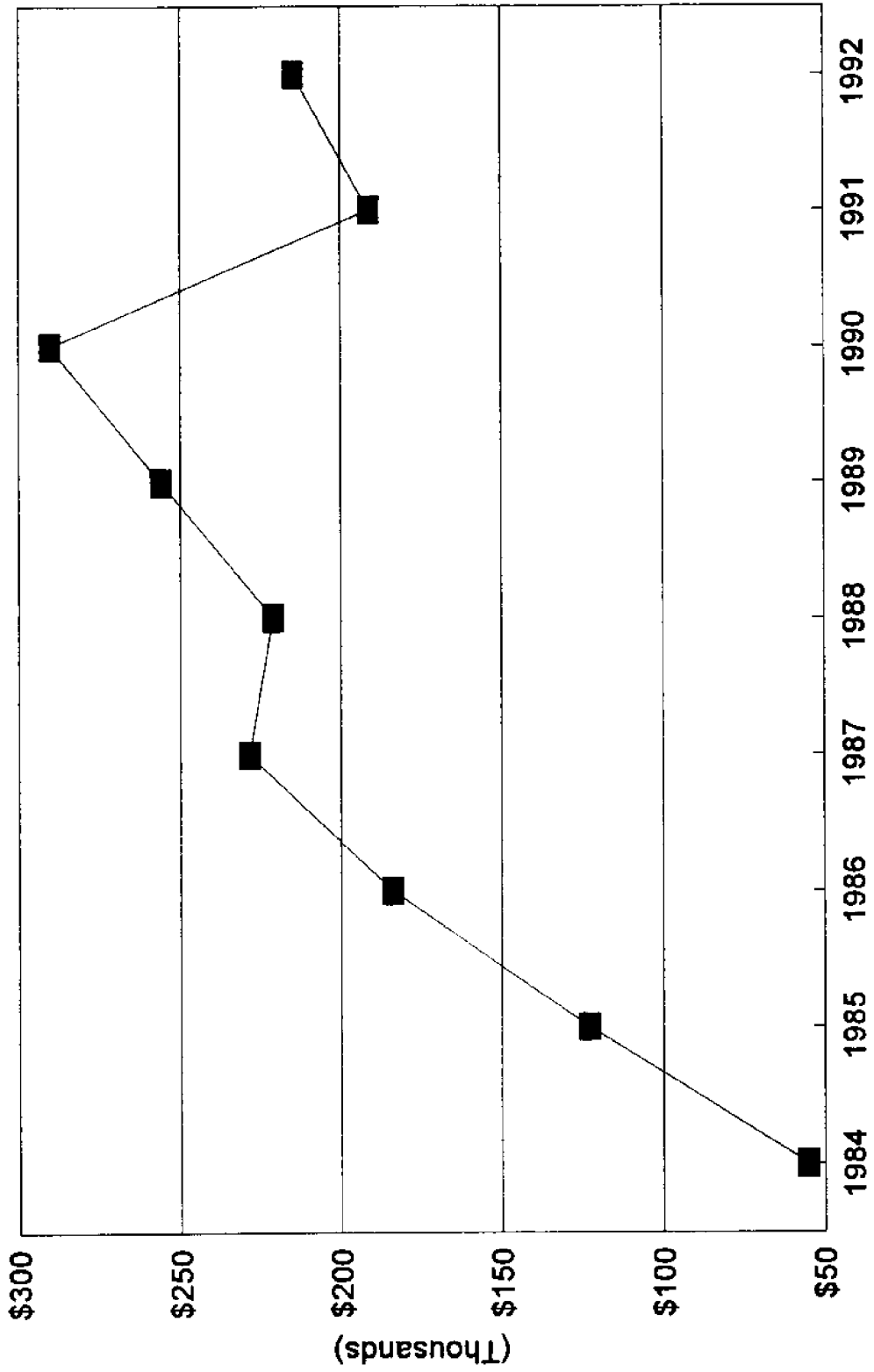

TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX PROCEEDS TOTAL DISTRICT III

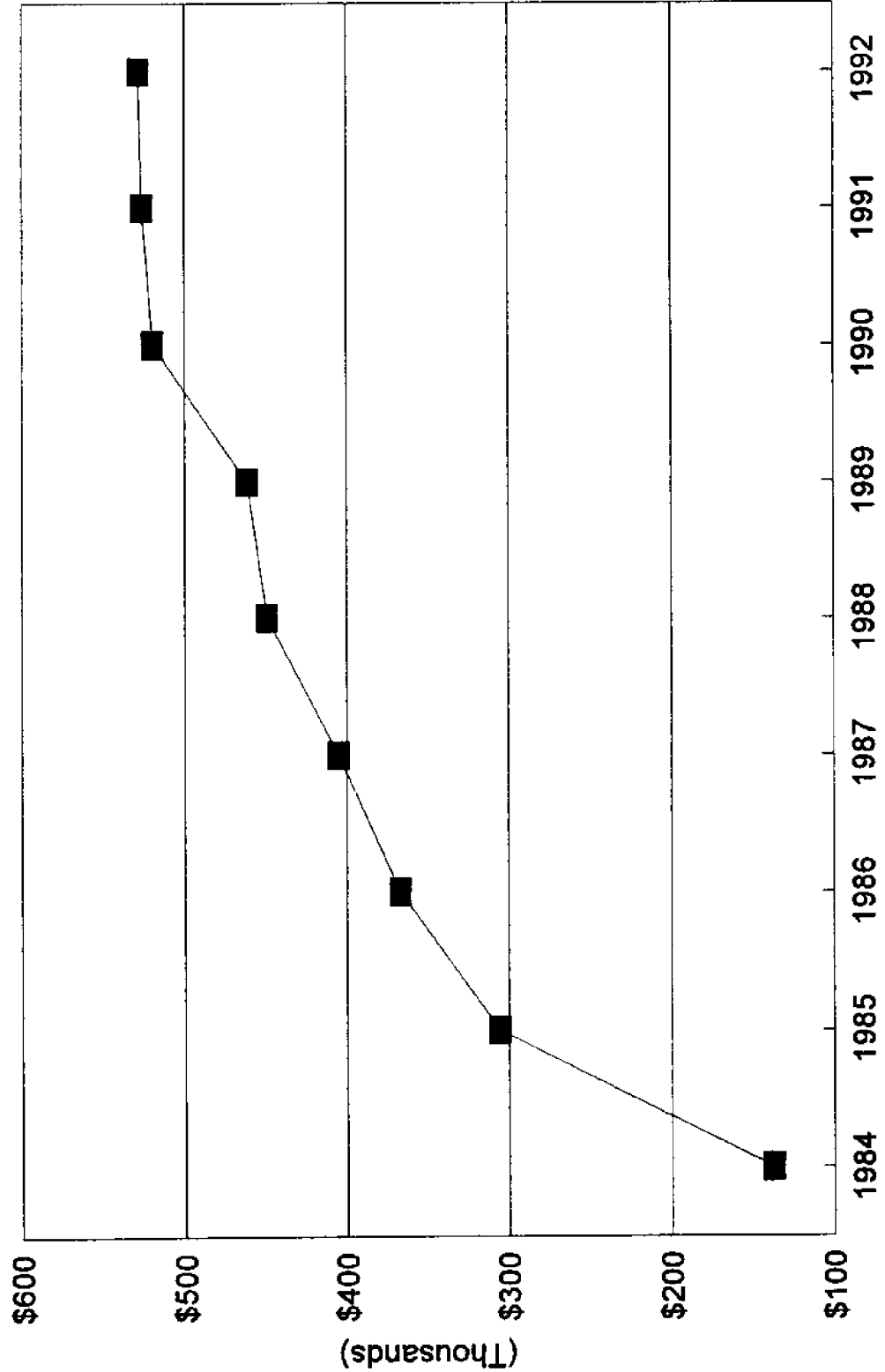

TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX PROCEEDS TOTAL DISTRICT IV

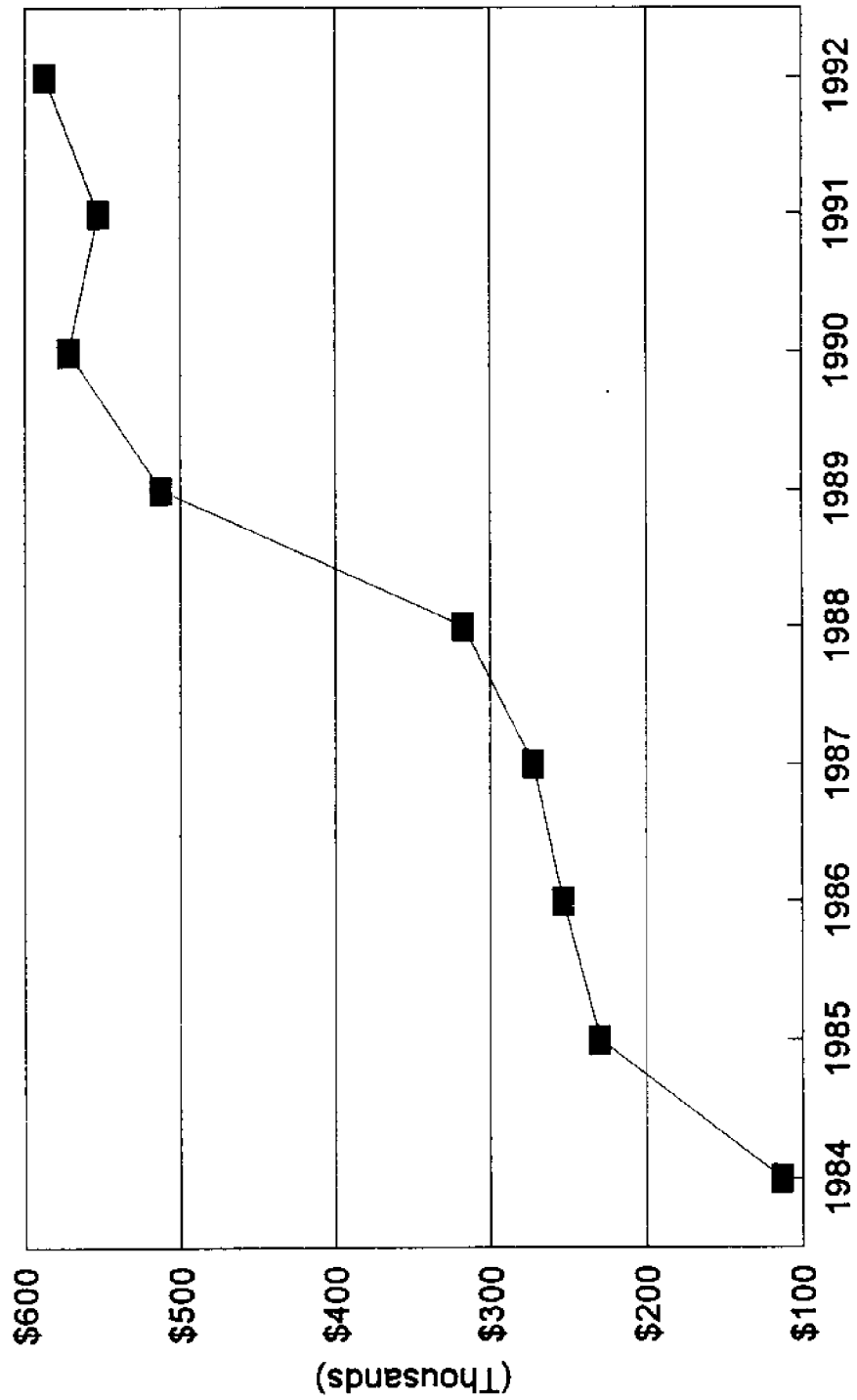
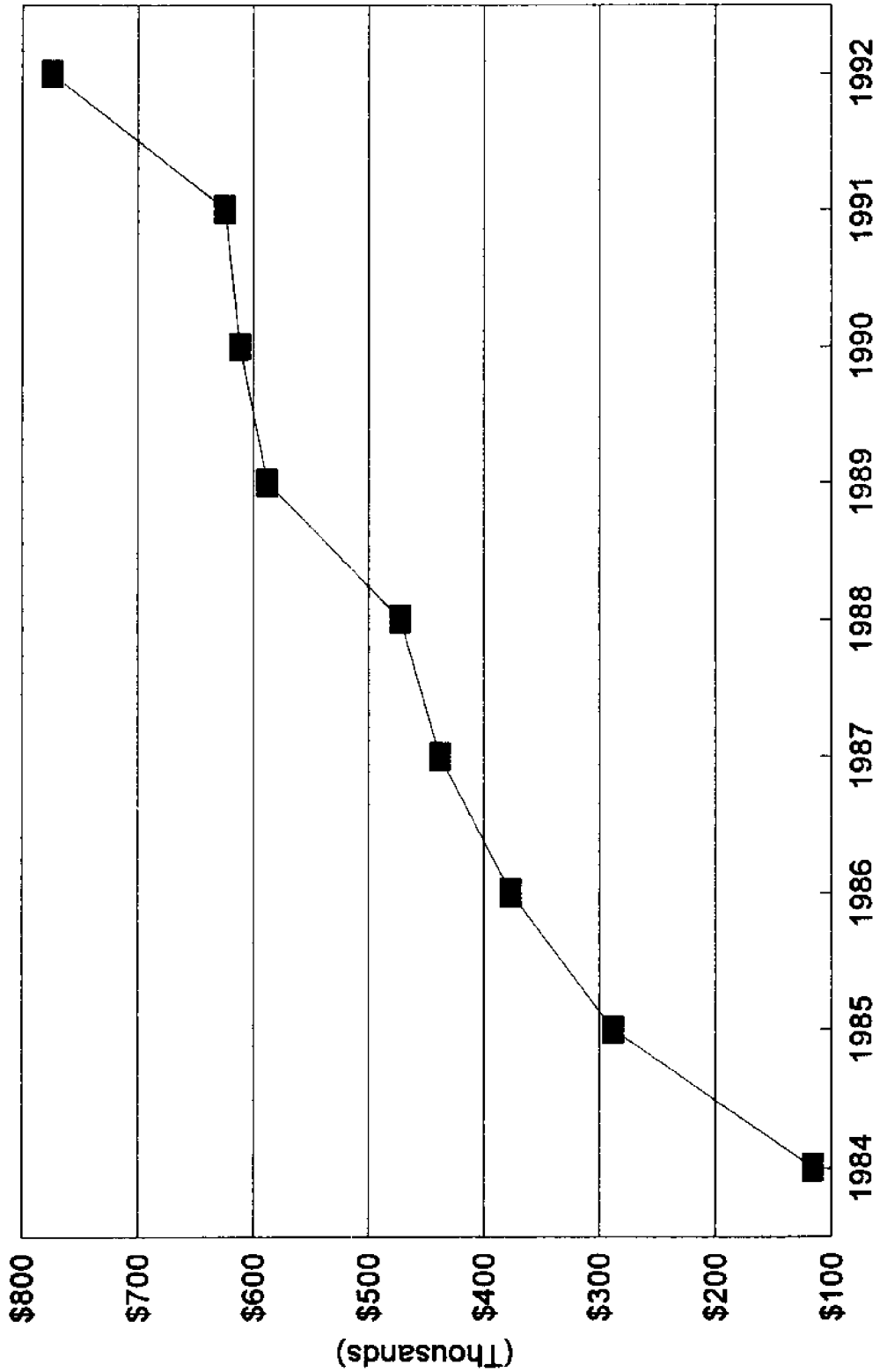

1992: TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX PROCEEDS TOTAL ALL DISTRICTS

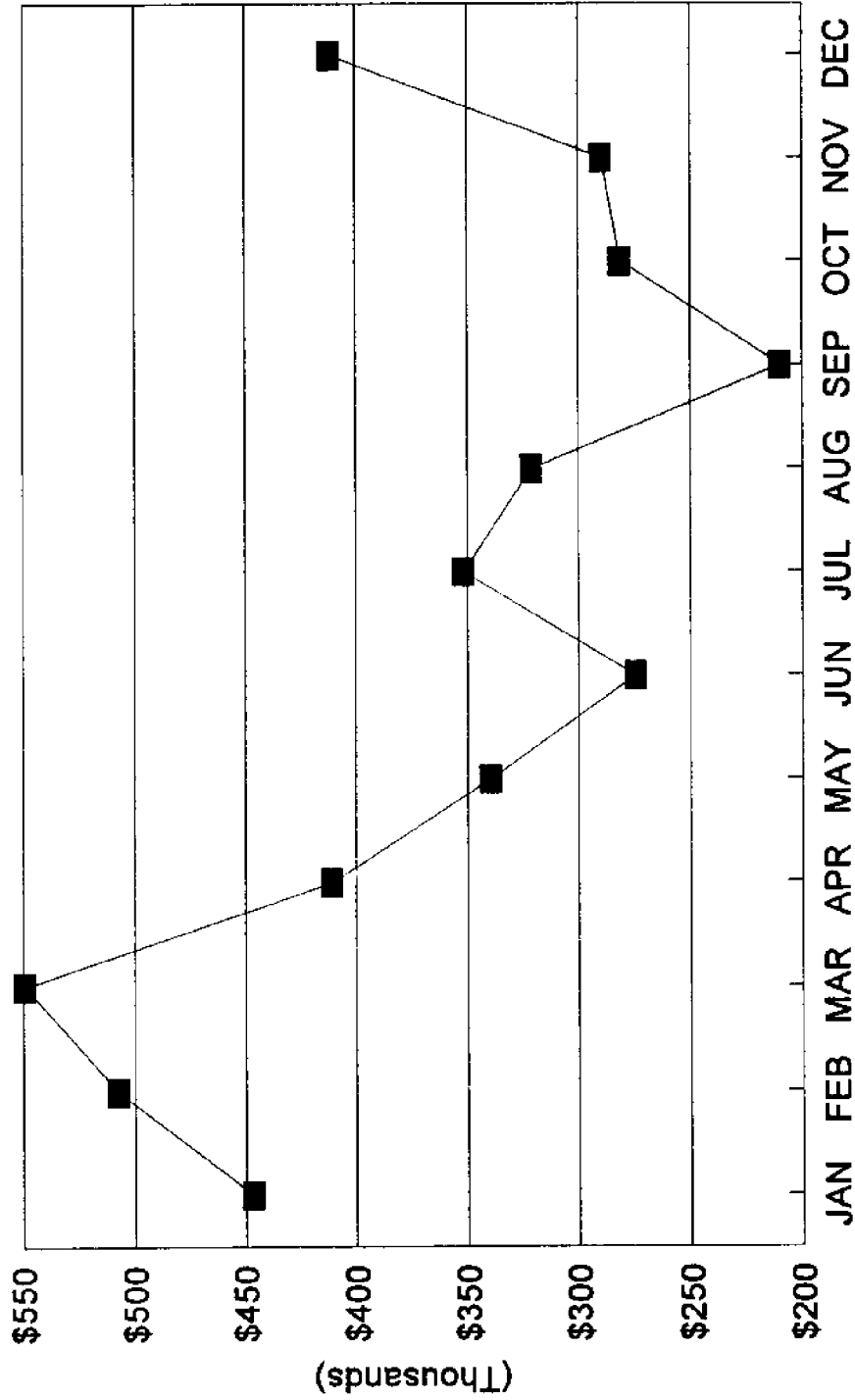

1992: TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX PROCEEDS DISTRICT I

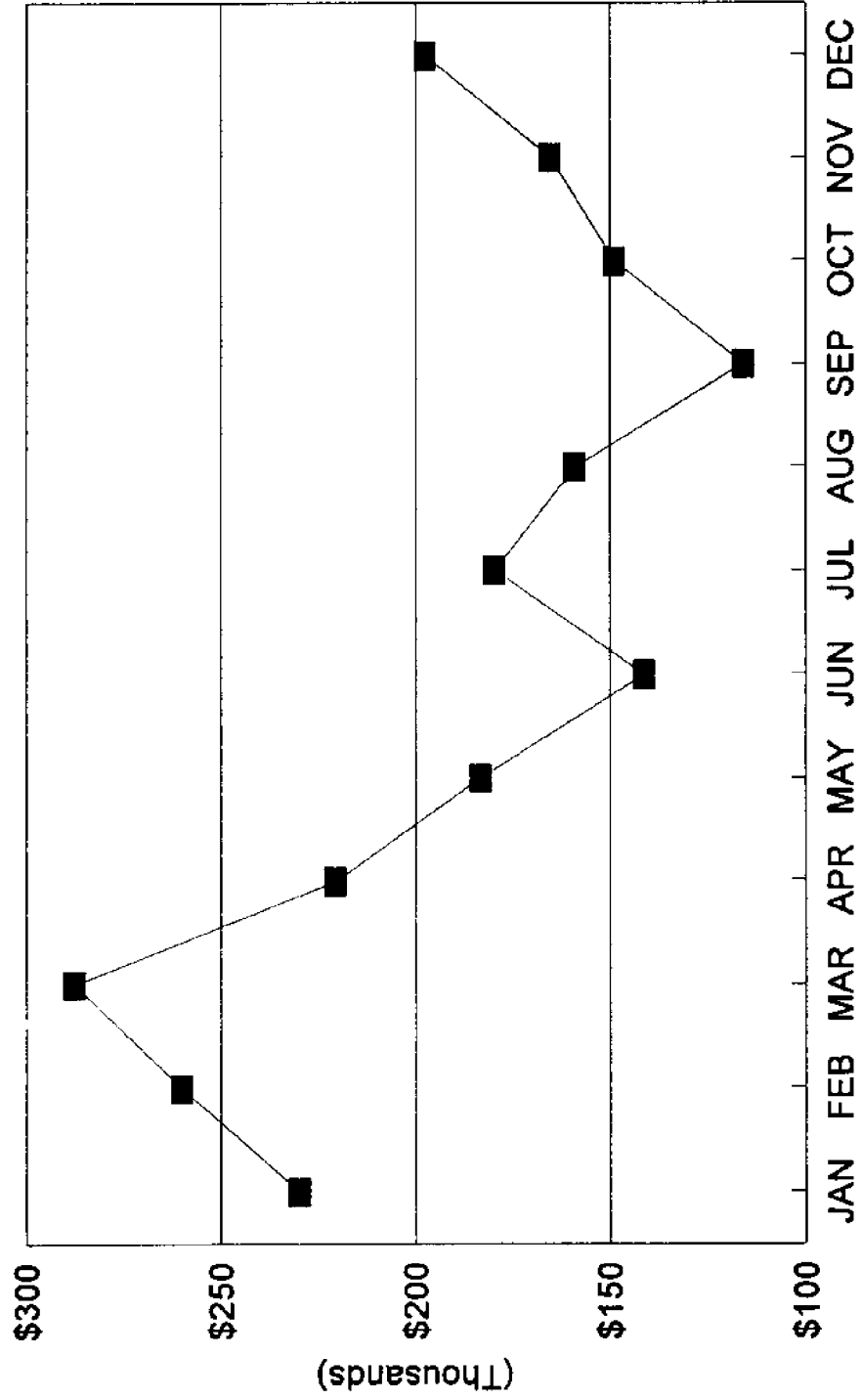

1992: TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX PROCEEDS DISTRICT II

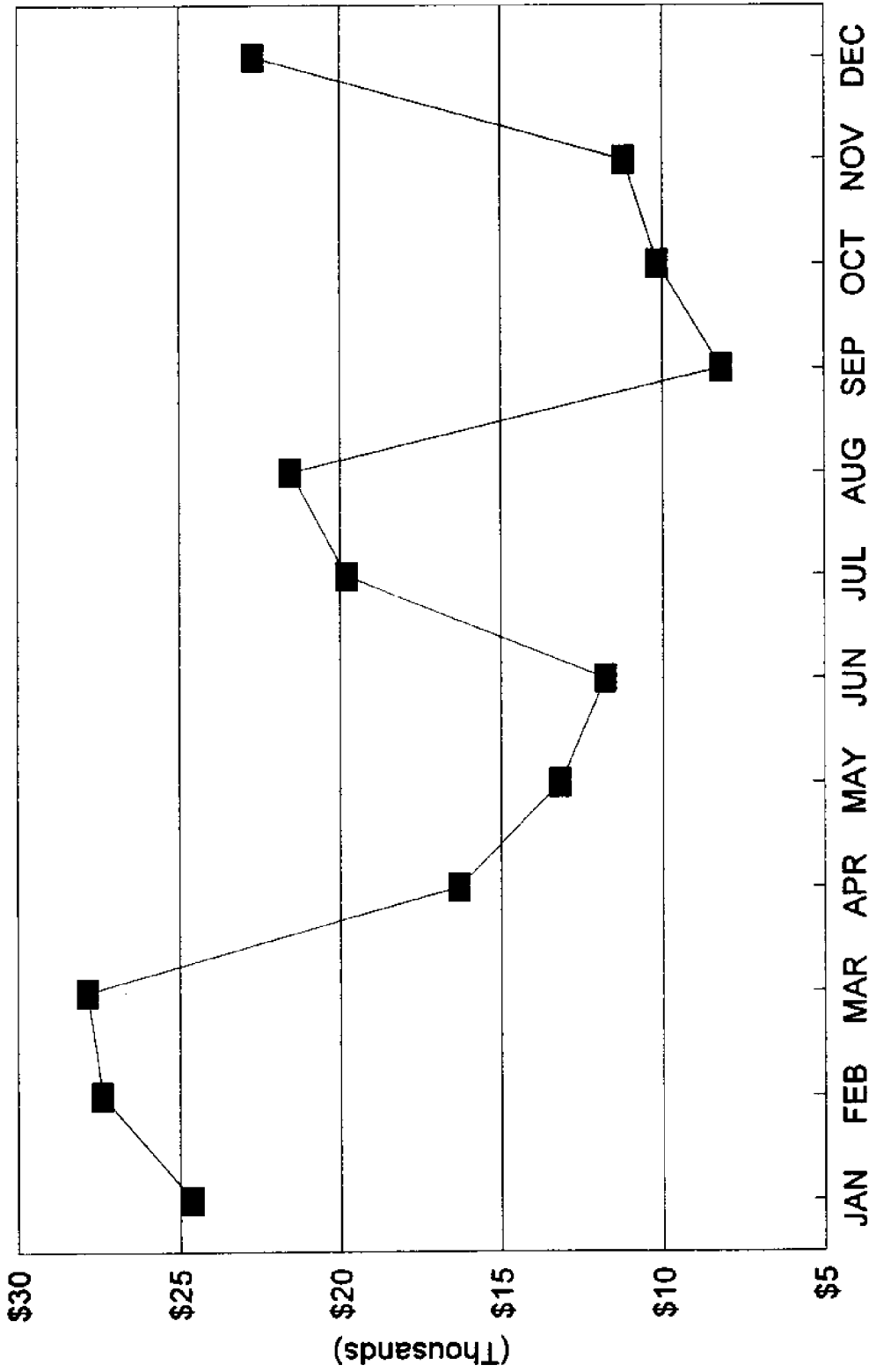
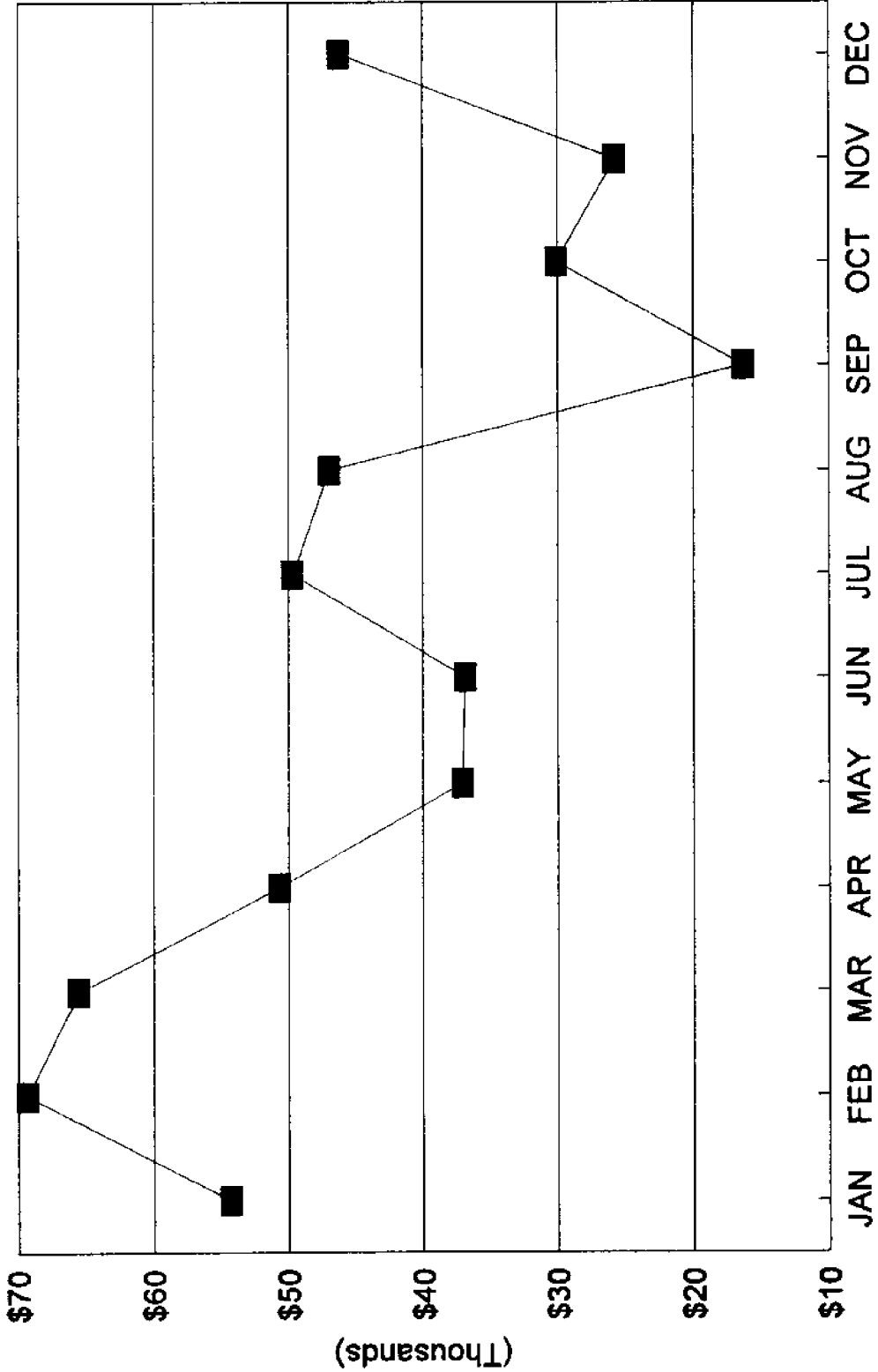
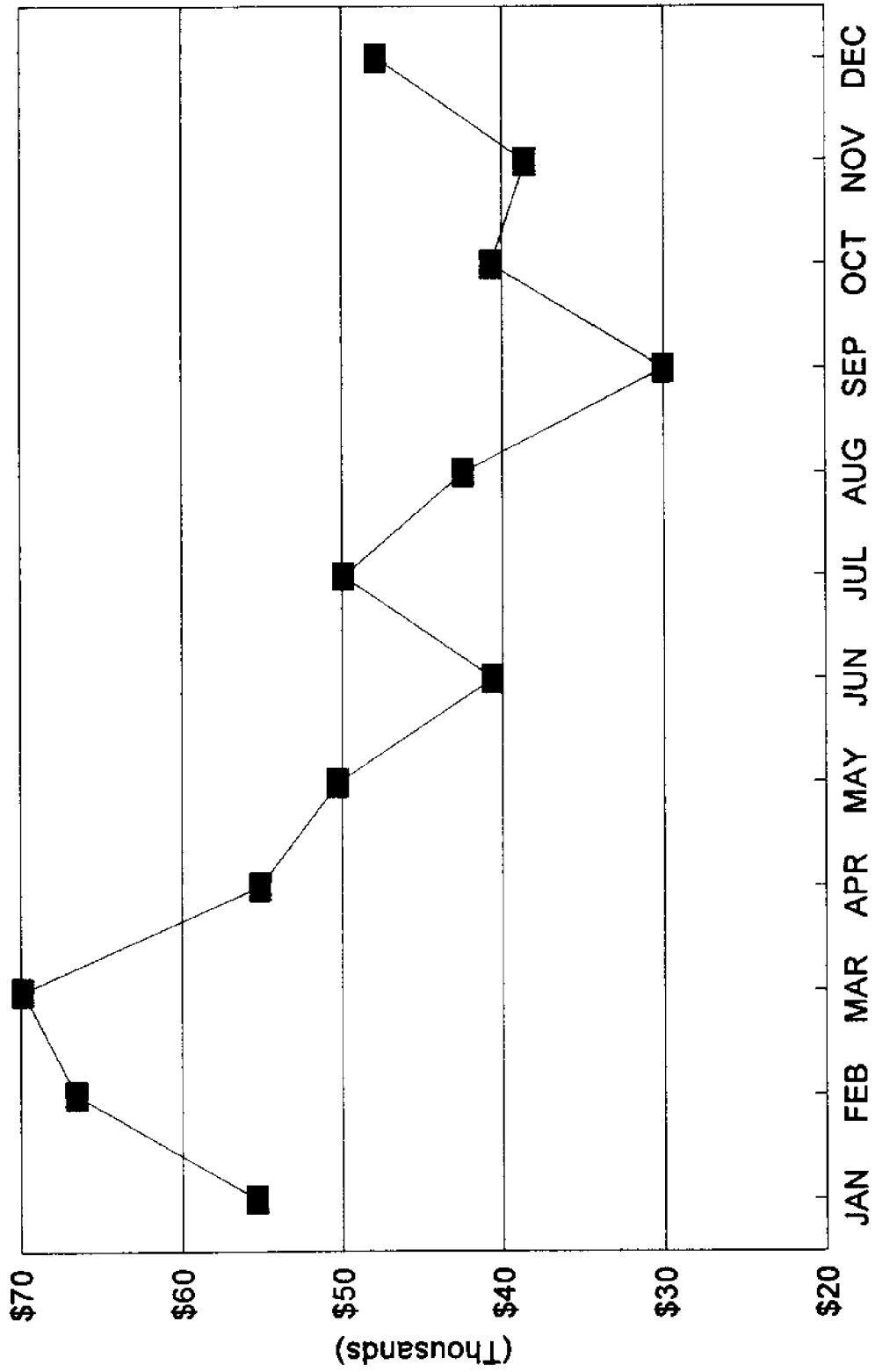

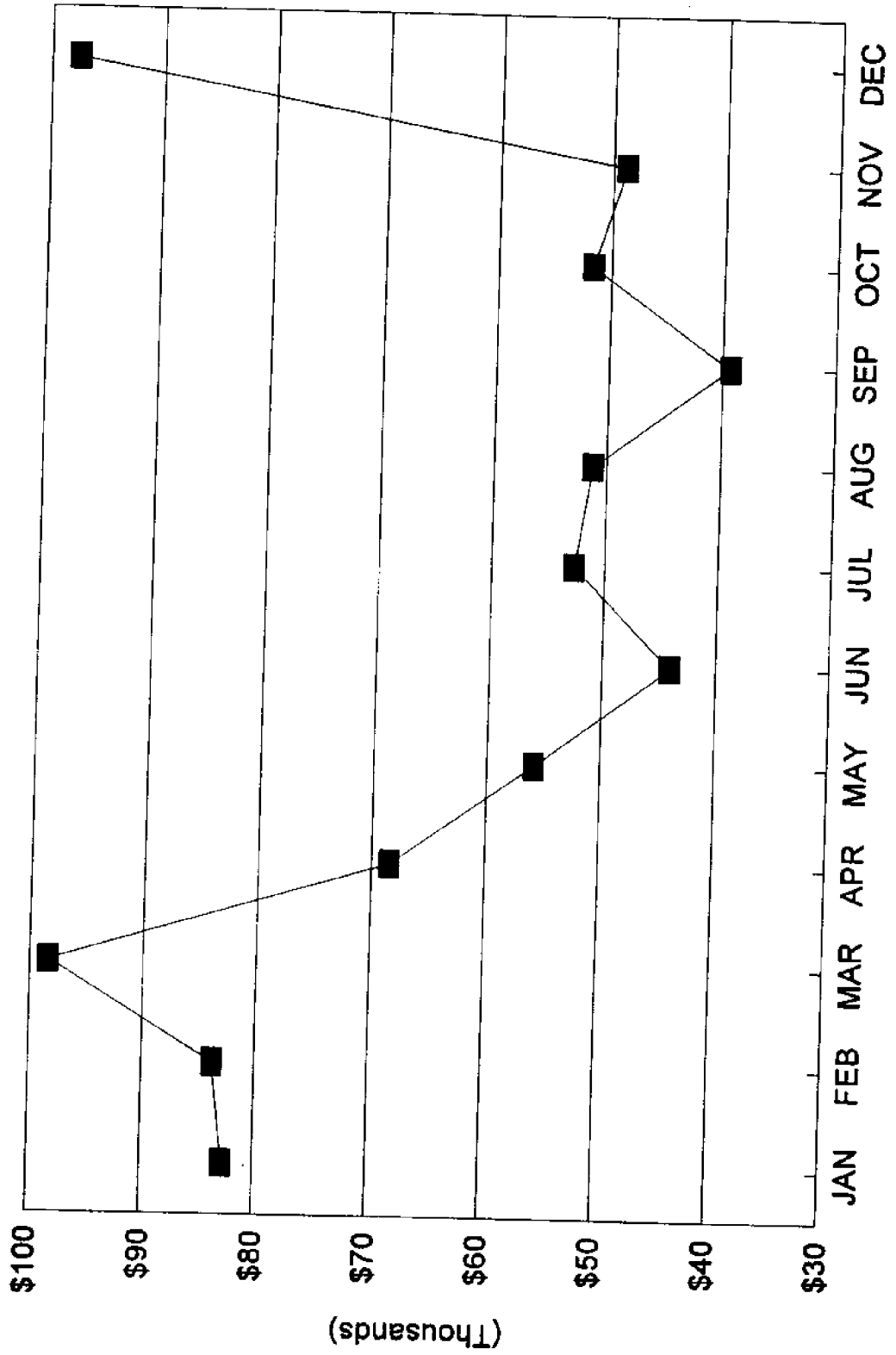
1992: TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX PROCEEDS DISTRICT III

COMMERCIAL AND RECREATIONAL FISHING

The commercial and recreational fishing industries are vitally important to the Monroe County economy. This section focuses on "indicator" data which are useful in observing trends in these two industries. Unfortunately, not all of the data are available through the 1993-94 period, which would allow a "before and after the storm" assessment (Table CRF1).

The number of retail seafood dealers has declined over the last 7 years. There were 162 retail seafood dealers in Monroe County during 1987. This decreased to 138 in 1993. The number of wholesale seafood dealers has increased during the 1987 to 1993 period. The number of wholesale dealers increased from 68 in 1987 to 103 in 1993. In contrast, the number of licensed commercial fishermen has apparently decreased during the 1989 period. The number of Saltwater Products License holders decreased from 4157 in 1989 to 3052 in 1993. Commercial fishery landings have also exhibited a decreasing trend over the last few years. Commercial landings decreased from 21.8 million pounds in 1987 to 16.3 million pounds in 1991, the last year county- wide data are available. Interestingly, the numbers of registered commercial boats and vessels increased during the 1989 to 1993 period. The number of registered commercial craft increased from 3458 in 1989-90 to 3922 in 1992-93. Registrations for the 1993-94 period are not available.

The number of recreational saltwater fishing licenses sold in Monroe County has been increasing during the 1990 to 1994 period. Resident saltwater licenses increased from 36,961 in 1990-91 (sales during the period June 90 to June 91) to 38,996 in 1992-93. The total number sold for the period June 1993 to March 1994 (the latest data available) represents a 7 percent increase over the same period during 1992-93. The number of nonresident saltwater licenses has shown a similar, but even more dramatic, increasing trend. There were 37,684

nonresident licenses sold during 1990-91. Sales increased to 44,326 during 1992-93. Sales during the June 1993 to March 1994 period represent a 2 percent increase over the same period during the previous year.

SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

This report has presented selected data for economic variables in Monroe County, Florida in an effort to increase understanding of the local economy. Together, these data paint a picture of the unique features of Monroe County. Several points are important, but all add up to a seasonal economy dependent on tourism for much of the recreational activity. This conclusion is supported by several features of the data.

The primary consideration is the seasonality evident in the data. Whether examining employment data, sales data, or proceeds from the tourism development tax, seasonal patterns are similar. The Monroe County economy reaches a high point in the winter months of the tourism season and low points occur during the late summer months. Further, when data are examined on a monthly basis for several years, there seems to be no tendency for the seasonal pattern to diminish. Growth has tended only to increase the levels of economic activity and has had little effect on the diversity of the local economy.

The conclusion above is further supported by the concentration of employment within the tourism related components of the local economy. A majority of employment is generated by the retail sales and service sectors of the local area. The concentration is less marked for income generation only because of the predominant role of investment income and transfer payments into the local area.

From an income perspective, Monroe County per capita income exceeds that of the state of Florida and has since the mid -1980's. Again, this perhaps reflects the importance of investment income (dividends, rents and interest) and transfer payments. Population has increased in the county, but population increases have been less than those experienced by the state as a whole. Population projections indicate that this trend is likely to continue.

In summary, Monroe County is growing slower than the state as a whole, economic activity is concentrated in tourism/service related activities, economic activity exhibits a marked seasonality, and most importantly, there seems to be little if any indication of change in past trends and/or seasonality patterns.
