

## 2023 5-Year Review for Central California Coast Coho Salmon - Errata

On May 2, 2023 National Marine Fisheries Service's West Coast Region published the most recent 5-year review for Central California Coast (CCC) coho salmon. Upon later review of the published document it was noted that two citations were incorrect:

1) The citation SWFSC 2022 was incorrectly listed in the references section as:

SWFSC (Southwest Fisheries Science Center). 2022. DRAFT Viability assessment for Pacific salmon and steelhead listed under the Endangered Species Act: Southwest. 22 February 2022 Report to National Marine Fisheries Service – West Coast Region from Southwest Fisheries Science Center, Fisheries Ecology Division 110 McAllister Way, Santa Cruz, California 95060

This was intended to cite to the final assessment document from July of 2022, and should read:

SWFSC (Southwest Fisheries Science Center). 2022. Viability assessment for Pacific salmon and steelhead listed under the Endangered Species Act: Southwest. 11 July 2022 Report to National Marine Fisheries Service – West Coast Region from Southwest Fisheries Science Center, Fisheries Ecology Division 110 McAllister Way, Santa Cruz, California 95060.

2) The citation to 64 FR 56253 on page 48 of the document is incorrect; the correct citation where the referenced language is found is 64 FR 50414 (Endangered and Threatened Species; Threatened Status for Two Chinook Salmon Evolutionarily Significant Units (ESUs) in California) which was published on September 16, 1999.

The citation in the references section also should have been:

64 FR 50414. Endangered and Threatened Species; Threatened Status for Two Chinook Salmon Evolutionarily Significant Units (ESUs) in California. Federal Register 64 FR 50394-50415.

We regret any confusion these errors may have caused. These corrections have no impact on the analyses, conclusions, or recommendations presented in the 5-year review.
