FOREWORD

This is an updated version of the very popular Foreign Fisheries Leaflet No. 2, issued by the Division of Foreign Fisheries (then the Office of Foreign Fisheries) in February 1969. The purpose of the first issue was to provide, under one cover, information on the shrimp fishing industries of the world in order to answer the most common questions on the subject. Most of the information provided in the 1969 edition came from replies to a request to selected U.S. Embassies and Consulates by the Department of State asking for information requested by the International Shrimp Council. Replies were compiled in this Division and augmented with other materials. The 1969 edition represented the best information then available at the time.

It was found, however, that the Leaflet was useful for answering much more than information on the shrimp industry. The fishing companies and exporters listed were in many, if not most, instances the producers and exporters of many other seafood products. Also, the Government agencies cited for shrimp industry administration and sanitation were the agencies responsible for other fishery industries.


In revising and updating the 1969 report, attention was given to making the new edition reflect the general need the original edition was not designed to serve, but which it served so usefully. Accordingly, in the instruction to selected U.S. Embassies and Consulates, emphasis was placed on obtaining current data of a general nature which might be used to provide information on the entire fishing industry (rather than just the shrimp industry) in each of the countries included.

As may be seen from the materials in the new edition, the Embassies and Consulates did an excellent job in obtaining the desired information. We acknowledge the invaluable assistance of Henry Williamson, Asst. Chief, and John Curry, Projects Officer, of the Foreign Reporting Division, Bureau of Economic Affairs, U.S. Department of State.

The Division of Foreign Fisheries provides information on the fishing industries of the world to the U.S. fishing industry, the U.S. Government, and the academic community. Types of fishery information routinely provided are catch statistics, foreign trade, fishing fleet censuses, investment opportunities, and foreign laws and regulations.

We hope that this updated edition of Foreign Fisheries Leaflet No. 2 will be responsive to those whose requests have prompted its updating, and will service the needs of those end users for whom we have prepared it.

Prices have been declining for several years due to a serious shortage of skilled labor to peel and devein the shrimp. A large portion of the catch must be frozen without deveining, limiting the market potential for Dutch shrimp. In addition, the massive flood control and reclamation projects in the Rhine estuary are destroying the breeding grounds for shrimp.

Swedish exports of fish to the United States are relatively insignificant, being confined mainly to canned anchovies, salted or pickled herring (sill), caviar, sardines, various kinds of shellfish and other Scandinavian fish specialties. In 1970 exports of fish and fish products to the United States were valued at only Skr 1.6 million (\$310,000). Sweden, on the other hand, imports rather substantial quantities of shrimp from the United States. In 1970 such imports amounted to 3,542 metric tons, of which 2,916 tons consisted of frozen unpeeled shrimp, 486 tons were frozen peeled, 79 tons were canned shrimp, and 61 tons were other shrimp.

Note: Sanitary standards in Sweden are generally high by international comparison and the Swedish pure food laws are rigid. Under current legislation, the sale and distribution of imported foods can be prohibited if they do not conform with the standards applying to foods produced domestically. Moreover, the customs authorities may prevent the importation into Sweden of food products containing additives (coloring matter, preservatives, and the like) that are not mentioned in a special listing of approved additives to food published annually by the Swedish Board of Trade (Kungl. Kommerskollegium). Food importers can also be required to submit to the customs authorities a written statement to the effect that a given food product does not contain a non-approved additive.
