Analysis of Full Approval Decision

In view of the information and analysis presented in the attached Environmental Assessment evaluating consequences related to the federal action about the Michigan Coastal Nonpoint Pollution Control Program, it is hereby determined that finding that Michigan has satisfied all conditions of approvability on its program will not significantly impact the quality of the human environment, as described above and in the supporting Programmatic Environmental Assessment. In addition, all beneficial and adverse impacts of the proposed action have been addressed to reach the conclusion of no significant impacts. Accordingly, preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement for this action is not necessary.
