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INTRODUCTION

This office note updates TDL Office Note 89-5 (Glahn 1989) which lists publications by Techniques Development Laboratory (TDL) employees. The initial office note listed documents from 1964 to 1989. The current office note contains a complete list for 1989 and continues by year until 1997. Obviously, the listing for 1997 is premature at this time, but encompasses articles that are in the process of being published. As was stated in Glahn (op. cit.), "publication dates do not necessarily coincide with when the work was done or the paper written. To be included in this list, some involvement of the author with the paper while at TDL was necessary, or affiliation with TDL was mentioned in the paper."

This office note includes contributions to books and journals, publications in the NOAA technical memorandum series, NOAA computer program series, TDL office notes, Technical Procedures Bulletins (TPB's) written by TDL authors, and extended abstracts published in conference or symposium programs. Note that the latter two types of documentation were not listed in the first office note. Since the National Weather Service's Office of Meteorology now attributes the TPB's to specific authors and the TPB's are subjected to a rigorous review process, we have included them in the publication list. Theses and dissertations are not included in this office note, nor are TDL contributions to various progress reports (for example, the World Meteorological Organization reports on numerical weather prediction).
